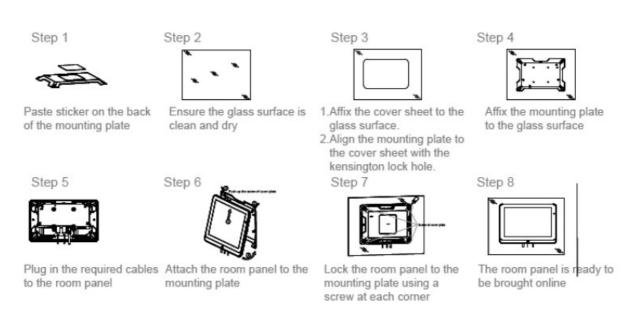

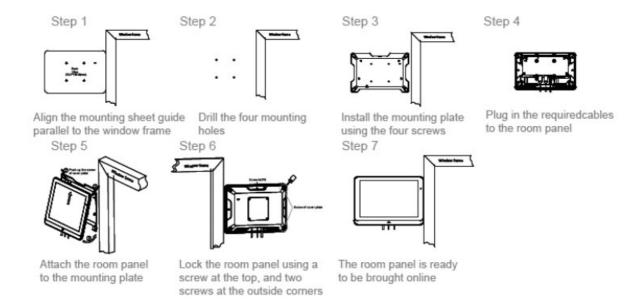
option 1: Flush Wall Mount



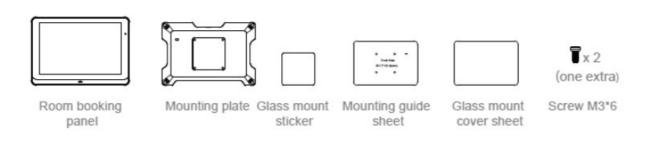
option 2: Mounting close to a window frame



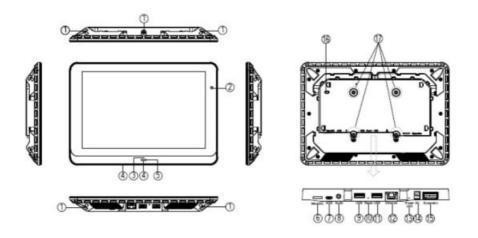
option3: Mounting close to a window frame
