


Parts Descriptions




- 1. USB Type-C Port
- 2. Auto Focus/Rotate Button
 - Press once: Auto Focus
 - Press and hold: Flip Image 0°/180°
- 3. LED Touch Button Press to turn on the LED light (3 levels of brightness control)
- 4. Manually Flip the Camera Head $0^{\circ} 180^{\circ}$
- 5. Bolts
- 6. Base Plate
- 7. LED Indicator
- 8. Built-in Microphone
- 9. Camera lens
- 10. LED Light

Getting Started 1

1. Lift the camera arm to extend the document camera.




2. Press against the base plate of the camera and pull it up, then flip the camera head into position.



Getting Started 2


- 1. Plug the supplied USB cable to the camera and connect the other end into the computer's USB port.
- 2. Attach the cable clips to the camera arm to fix the USB cable.

The QPC5 is a standard UVC camera that can be used with a variety of software including third-party video conferencing software Zoom, Microsoft Teams, or Google Meet. However, to get the full functionality of this 4K document camera, we recommend using it with the included QOMO Camera software for document cameras. 
