USING INSTRUCTION

- 1. Remove both transmitters from the charging case, remove the stickers covering their charging pins, and then return them to the case.
- 2. Remove both transmitters from the case again their LEDs will begin to flash, indicating they are now powered on.
- 3. Remove the receiver from the case and connect it directly to your phone its LEDs will flash to indicate it is pairing, and then remain solid when paired.
- 4. Start recording!
