CARE & MAINTENANCE

- Steer clear of harsh cleansers: Avoid using chemical or abrasive cleaners as they may harm the device.
- Verify the blue light's functionality by checking it; if it doesn't, replace the gadget.
- Maintain Clear Vents: Look for and clear any debris obstructing the ventilation or light openings.
- **Keep Extra Cartridges in Stock Correctly**: To preserve the quality of the adhesive, store refill cartridges in a cool, dry location.
- Avoid Excessive Heat: Keep the gadget away from heat sources such as stoves and radiators.
- Avoid Moisture: To prevent damage, stay away from damp areas and water.
- Examine the Power Connection: For safe operation, make sure the outlet and plug are clean and undamaged.
- Safe Cartridge Disposal: To prevent spills, place old glue cartridges in a bag before throwing them away.

The light not turning on	Burnt-out light or faulty connection	Check the light; replace it if necessary.
Trap not catching insects	Poor placement or low inse ct activity	Place in areas with higher insect activity and avoid brig ht surrounding lights.
Adhesive backing is no t effective	Cartridge expired or overfill ed	Replace the cartridge with a new refill.
The device makes unusual noise	Faulty internal components	Contact customer support for a replacement or repair.
Blue light flickering	Loose connection or ean le ctrical issue	Check the power outlet and ensure proper connection.
Cartridges filling too qui ckly	High insect activity	Check and replace cartridges more frequently as needed.
Device overheating	Prolonged use without ventil ation	Ensure proper airflow and do not block vents around the device.
Insects escaping the tr ap	Improper cartridge installati on	Reinstall the cartridge securely, ensuring no gaps are p resent.
Refills unavailable	Supply issues or local unav ailability	Order refills online from official or trusted sellers.


