Backlight setting

- FN+ (Alt_RI) : Switch backlighting effects, total 20 patterns.

- FN+ (WINI) :Lock Windows key and APP key, repeat to unlock.
- FN+ (Space) : Switch the color (total 7 colors)in single color backlight pattern.

FAQ

1. If the keyboard doesn't respond, please check if the keyboard's USB cable is correctly inserted into the corresponding USB port on the computer, or try another USB port on the computer.
2. If you spill liquid on the keyboard, please remove keyboard's USB cable from the computer immediately. Wipe up excess liquid and put the keyboard in a warm place (for instance, under a lamp) to let the keyboard dry naturally before using again.

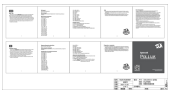
FCC Statement
