RedThunder G30-C One Handed Gaming Keyboard




Overview

The RedThunder One-Handed Gaming Keyboard and Mouse Combo (Model G30-C) has comprehensive instructions in this handbook. This game-focused wired combo includes a gaming mouse with up to 6400 DPI and a small, ergonomic 35-key keyboard with RGB backlighting. To guarantee correct operation and to get the most out of your gaming experience, please read this manual carefully before using the product.



Setup Unpacking

Gently take the mouse and keyboard out of the box. Make sure every element is there.



Connection:

- Find a USB port on your PC, PS4, or other device.
- Insert the RedThunder keyboard's USB connector into the USB port.
- Connect the RedThunder mouse's USB connector to a different USB port that is open.

Installing drivers:

The mouse and keyboard are plug-and-play devices. Usually, drivers install themselves immediately when you connect. Basic operation does not require the installation of extra software. If you want more advanced modification (such mouse DPI software), visit the manufacturer's website.


System Compatibility:

Chrome OS, Linux, macOS, and Windows can all use this combination.

Instructions for Operation

Keyboard Features

Keys for Macro Recording:



- 'FN + F1' and 'FN + F2' are the keyboard's two sets of macro recording keys.
- To begin macro recording, press FN + ESC until the backlight flashes.
- Enter the key sequence that you want to record.
- To save and stop recording, press FN + F1 or FN + F2.
- Press either FN + F1 or FN + F2 to start the recorded macro. The output will be the relevant recorded content.

RGB Backlighting Control:



- The keyboard has RGB backlighting that comes in seven different colors and two different light modes (static and breathing).
- Press FN + F3 to change the color of the backlight.
- To switch between light modes, press FN + F4.
- To activate or deactivate the backlighting, press FN + F5.



Keycap Design:

• To improve longevity and lighting effects, the keyboard uses two-color keycaps.

Ergonomic Design:

• To provide comfortable use during prolonged gaming sessions, the keyboard has a sizable wrist rest. Mouse Features

DPI Settings:

 With a maximum DPI of 6400, the gaming mouse offers accurate control and versatility in a wide range of game genres. The user can change the DPI to their own level.

Polling Rate:

- To provide fluid and fast movement tracking, the mouse has a polling rate of up to 1000 Hz.
- Eight buttons are programmable on the mouse, including a "Fire Button" that may be set up to perform quick operations (e.g., 1 click = 3 left clicks).

The mouse has seven different illumination modes:

- Wave, Four Seasons, Waltz, DPI, Rainbow, Rolling, and Off. It also contains Chroma RGB backlighting.
- The color of the lighting matches the current DPI setting while in DPI mode.
- It could be possible to alter the color of each DPI setting with specialized software.

Ergonomic Design:

The mouse's soft feel and comfortable grip make it ideal for prolonged use.

Maintenance Cleaning

Clean the keyboard and mouse's surfaces using a gentle, dry cloth. A slightly moist towel can be used to remove tough dirt, but make sure no liquid gets within the device. Avoid using abrasive cleaning or strong chemicals.

Storage:

Keep the combination out of direct sunlight and extremely hot or cold conditions while not in use.

Cable Care:

To avoid damaging the USB cords, do not bend or twist them excessively.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the RedThunder G30-C One Handed Gaming Keyboard?

The RedThunder G30-C is a compact 35-key RGB backlit gaming keypad with a

built-in game chip, designed to deliver faster response times and a space-saving layout for gamers.

How many keys does the RedThunder G30-C One Handed Gaming Keyboard have?

This model includes 35 keys, with all keys supporting anti-ghosting, ensuring smooth and accurate inputs during gaming.

Does the RedThunder G30-C One Handed Gaming Keyboard support macro recording?

The G30-C features two dedicated macro keys (FN+F1 and FN+F2), allowing users to record and execute custom commands for gaming convenience.

How can I record macros on the RedThunder G30-C One Handed Gaming Keyboard?

Press FN+ESC until the backlight flashes, type your desired command, then press FN+F1 or FN+F2 to save. The macro will execute when you press the assigned key.

How do I clear a macro on the RedThunder G30-C One Handed Gaming Keyboard?

To clear, press FN+ESC until the backlight flashes, then press the macro key (FN+F1 or FN+F2) you want to reset.

Does the RedThunder G30-C One Handed Gaming Keyboard support RGB lighting?

The G30-C offers 7 RGB backlight colors, with breathing and static modes to enhance your gaming setup.

Is the RedThunder G30-C One Handed Gaming Keyboard portable?

Its lightweight and compact size makes it easy to carry and ideal for gamers who travel.
