Safety Instructions




AVOID MOST PROBLEMS BY CAREFULLY STORING PRODUCTS.



- Store windows in a controlled environment.
- Store windows in a clean, dry, low traffic area.
- Cut slits in wrapping or completely remove wrapping for storage.
- Store windows standing up and with no weight against them.



WARNING, BENDING OR WAVES CAN OCCUR IN HIGH TEMPS OR WHEN IMPROPERLY STORED!



- DO NOT store in direct sunlight.
- DO NOT store in high heat.
- DO NOT lay windows flat.
- DO NOT stack products in a row as the glass units can get superheated.
- DO NOT place other materials on top of products.

Note: Improperly storing products can cause damage and void product warranty.
