

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

 This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been supervised/instructed and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be done by children unless they are older than 8 and supervised. Keep the appliance and cable out of reach of children under 8 years.

Do not use this appliance near bathtubs, showers, basins or other vessels containing water.

- When the appliance is used in a bathroom, unplug it after use since the proximity of water presents a hazard even when the appliance is switched off.
- For additional protection, the installation of a residual current device (RCD) having a rated residual operating current not exceeding 30 mA is advisable in the electrical circuit supplying the bathroom*.
 - * Currently, the fitting in a bathroom of an electrical socket suitable or capable of operating the appliance is not permitted in the UK (see BS7671).
- Burn hazard. Keep the appliance out of reach from young children, particularly during use and while cooling
 down.
- Never leave the appliance unattended when it is connected to the power supply.
- Always place the appliance with its stand, if any, on a heat-resistant, stable flat surface.
- If the supply cord of this unit becomes damaged, discontinue use immediately and return the appliance to your nearest authorised Remington® service dealer for repair or replacement in order to avoid a hazard. Do not allow any part of the appliance touch the face, neck or scalp.
- · Keep the power plug and cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not use attachments other than those we supply.
- Do not use the appliance if it is damaged or malfunctions.
- Do not twist or kink the cable, or wrap it round the appliance. Check the cord regularly for any sign damage.
- This appliance is not intended for commercial or salon use.

PARTS

- 1. 25mm barrel with 4 x protection coating
- 2. Tong clip
- 3. On/Off button
- 4. Digital temperature display
- 5. Temperature control
- 6. Cool tip
- 7. Stand
- 8. Swivel cord

ADDITIONAL FEATURES

- Fast heat up—ready to use in 30 seconds.
- Automatic safety shut off this unit will switch itself off if no button is pressed or it is left on after 60 minutes.
- Multivoltage: for home or abroad. At 120V times and temperatures may vary.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- Before use, ensure the hair is clean, dry and tangle-free.
- For extra protection use a heat protection spray.

- Hairsprays contain flammable material do not use while using this product.
- · Section the hair prior to styling. Style the lower layers first.
- 1. Plug in the appliance.
- 2. Push the on/off button to turn on.
- 3. To adjust the temperature, twist the temperature control left ◀ − or right ▶ + then release it to increase or decrease the temperature. As you twist the temperature control the temperature will be displayed on the digital display.
- 4. When the three bars on the display stop cycling up and down the appliance is ready to use.

Recommended Temperatures

Temperature	Hair type
130°C - 150°C	Thin / fine, damaged or bleached hair
160°C - 180°C	Normal, healthy hair
190°C - 220°C	Thick and difficult to style hair

- 5. Place a section of hair under the long tong clip (smaller sections create tighter curls larger sections create large curls or waves).
- 6. Turn the styler to roll the hair round the barrel.
- 7. Wait about 10 seconds for the curl to form.
- 8. Unwind the tong and release the curl.
- 9. Let the hair cool before styling.
- 10. Repeat this around the head to create as many curls as desired.
- 11. To turn off, press and hold the on/off button until the display goes out, then unplug the appliance.

Temperature Lock Function

- Set the desired temperature then lock the setting by holding the temperature control in the left

 − position
 until the symbol appears on the digital display.
- To unlock, twist and hold the temperature control in the left

 − position until the symbol disappears.

Temperature Boost Function

- For quick touch ups of stubborn, hard to style sections.
- The temperature boost function boosts the temperature to 220°C.
- Twist and hold the temperature control in the right position for 2 seconds.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- Unplug the appliance and allow to cool.
- · Wipe all the surfaces with a damp cloth.
- Don't use harsh or abrasive cleaning agents or solvents.

RECYCLING
