## Product Usage Instructions

### Locking and Unlocking:

- **LOCK Button:** Press this button to lock all doors.
- **UNLOCK Button:** Press to unlock the driver's door. Press again within 5 seconds to unlock all doors.

### Trunk and Power Back Door:

- **TRUNK Button:** Use this button to open and close the trunk.
- **POWER BACK DOOR Button:** Press to open and close the liftgate.

### Remote Start and Panic Button:

- **REMOTE START Button:** Press twice within 5 seconds to initiate Remote Start mode for a 15-minute cycle. Press once to exit the mode.
- **PANIC Button:** Activates the alarm system causing the horn and hazard lamp to sound. Press any button on the key to stop the alarm.

**FAQs (Frequently Asked Questions):****Q: How do I replace the battery in the electronic key?**

A: To replace the battery, follow these steps:

- Locate the battery compartment on the key.
- Open the compartment using a small screwdriver or coin.
- Remove the old battery and replace it with a new one, ensuring the correct polarity.
- Close the compartment securely.

**Q: How do I program a new remote transmitter with my vehicle?**

A: To program a new remote transmitter, refer to your vehicle's manual for specific instructions or contact a certified technician for assistance.

This remote has lock, unlock, Trunk, Power back door, Remote Start, and panic buttons; you can open or close the vehicle with the remote transmitter.

**BUTTONS DESCRIPTION****• LOCK Button:**

When you press the LOCK button, it locks all the doors

**• UNLOCK Button:**

Pressing the button unlocks the driver's door. Pressing the button again within 5 seconds unlocks the other doors.

**• TRUNK Button:**

Pressing the button opens and closes the trunk.

**• PANIC Button:**

When you press the PANIC button, the vehicle will start sounding the horn and flashing the hazard lamp. To

stop the alarm, press any button on the electronic key.

- **POWER BACK DOOR Button:**

Pressing the button opens and closes the liftgate.

- **REMOTE START Button:**

Press the remote start button twice within 5 seconds. The vehicle will stay in the Remote Start mode for a 15-minute cycle. Press and release the remote start button once to exit Remote Start mode.
