# **Product Usage Instructions**

# **LOCK Button**

Pressing the LOCK button will lock all the doors of the vehicle.

## **UNLOCK Button**

Pressing the UNLOCK button once will unlock the driver's door. Pressing it again within 5 seconds will unlock the other doors.

## A/C HOLD Button

The A/C HOLD button is used to control the air conditioning system. It can turn the system on or off. Adjust the temperature dial to set the desired level of cooling or heating.

# **Hatch Hold Button**

Pressing the Hatch Hold button will open or close the trunk of the vehicle.

#### **PANIC HOLD Button**

Pressing the PANIC button will activate the vehicle's alarm system, sounding the horn and flashing the hazard lamps. To stop the alarm, press any button on the electronic key.

## **FAQ**

- · Q: How do I change the battery of the electronic key?
  - A: To change the battery, locate the battery compartment on the key, remove the old battery, and insert a
    new one following the correct polarity.
- Q: Can I program additional functions to the electronic key?
  - A: The electronic key comes pre-programmed with specific functions and additional programming may not be possible. Refer to the user manual for any available customization options.

## **Product Information**

This remote has lock, unlock, Liftgate Unlock Hold Button, Forward button and Backward button, remote start Button and panic hold buttons; you can lock and unlock the vehicle doors and trunk/hatch with the remote transmitter.

- LOCK Button: When you press the LOCK button, it locks all the doors.
- UNLOCK Button: Pressing the button unlocks the driver's door. Pressing the button again within 5 seconds unlocks the other doors.
- A/C HOLD Button: The power button is the primary control that activates the air conditioning system. It turns the
  system on or off. When the AC is turned on, it starts cooling the air inside your vehicle. The temperature dial
  control allows you to adjust the level of cooling or heating.
- Hatch Hold Button: Pressing the button opens and closes the trunk.
- PANIC HOLD Button: When you press the PANIC button, the vehicle will start sounding the horn and flushing
  the hazard lamp. To stop the alarm, press any button on the electronic key.
