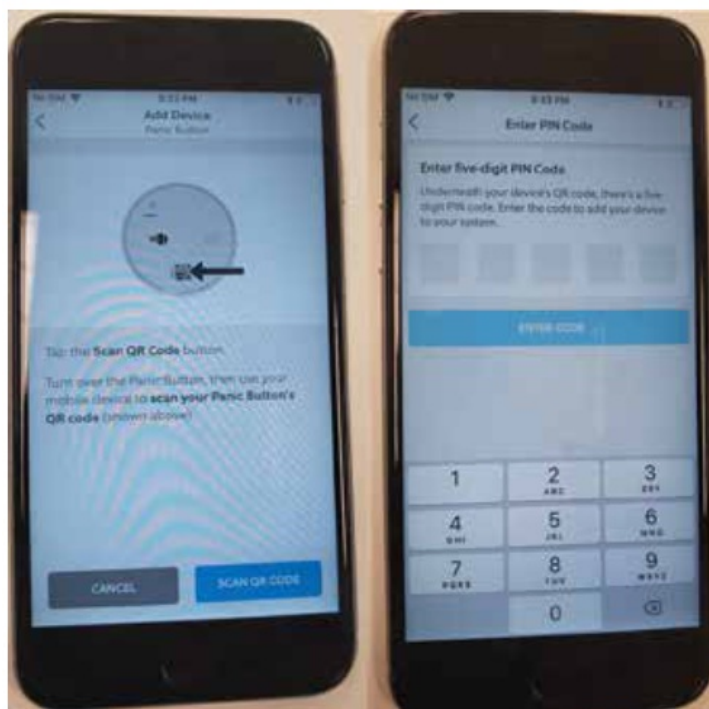

Instructions to locate Z-Wave DSK/QR code

Follow Device inclusion instructions provided in Ring Alarm mobile applications to locate QR codes and enter PIN Code



Factory Reset Instructions

Press and hold the Setup button for 10 seconds. When the LED ring stops blinking, Panic Button has reset. A factory reset disconnects the Panic Button from your Ring Alarm. To begin using the Panic Button again, repeat the setup process in the Ring app. Use this procedure only in the event that the network primary controller is missing or otherwise inoperable."

Association CC:

This sensor has one Association group of 1 node. Group 1 is the lifeline group that will receive unsolicited messages relating to Panic Button notifications, case tampering notifications, and low battery notifications.

Battery Level	A level of 0x64 indicates that the battery is new. A level of 0x63 indicates the battery is normal/ OK but not new. A level of 0x00 indicates that the battery should be changed "soon!" A battery level of OxFF indicates that the battery is dead and the sensor is no longer operational.	No
