Product Usage Instructions

Switching between Windows and Mac Systems:

Press Fn + A to switch to the Windows system and Fn + S to switch to the Mac system.

Adjusting Screen and Keyboard Backlight Brightness:

Use the respective keys to adjust screen brightness (\mathbf{oc} + to increase, \mathbf{oc} - to decrease) and keyboard backlight brightness (\mathbf{oc} y + to increase, \mathbf{oc} y - to decrease).

Media Control:

Control media playback with the dedicated keys:

Play/Pause: BNext Song: CLast Song: AMute/Unmute: B

• Volume Control: Use Volume+ oc + to increase volume and Volume- oc - to decrease volume.

- 5. Keep the keyboard in a suitable environment, free from extreme temperatures or humidity.



DISPLAY INFORMATION




- 1. Charging indication: always on when charging, fully off .Charge indicator light flashes guickly at low voltage.
- 2. Mode indicator light: The indicator light of the corresponding mode used by the user is always on (2.4 G/Bluetooth/wired)
- 3. FN + ENTER keyboard lock: Press FN + ENTER to lock the keyboard. The indicator light is on. Press FN + ENTER again to unlock the keyboard. The indicator light is off at this time.




WIRED CONNECTION

2.4 G MODE


Touch the switch to select "2.4G" mode:



Friendly reminder: The devices are already paired at the factory, so there is no need to pair them again.


BT CONNECTION

Touch the switch to select "B1/B2/B3" mode:




- Turn on the Bluetooth of the computer/mobile phone, search and connect the device, and search for the displayed name: RK M70




SECONDARY COMBINATION FUNCTION KEYS




SECONDARY COMBINATION FUNCTION KEYS
