SAL Push Button Switch is a mechanical push button ON/OFF switch, with different wiring options to enable/disable the LED indicator.





Installation process

- Make sure the key cap compatibility, fits a suitable keycap
- · Check and confirm the load compatibility
- Turn OFF the mains electricity supply before commencing installation
- · Connect the switch according to the wiring diagram
- Turn ON the mains electricity supply, then test the switch operation by pressing the switch button.

Warranty
