

Satechi USB4 Multiport Adapter with 8K HDMI Installation Guide


1. Connect the adapter to a USB-C port on your device.



2. Use the HDMI port to output 4K HDMI to an external monitor or display – up to 60Hz. Computer, cable and monitor need to support 8K macOS supports up to 4k at 60Hz




- 3. Use the USB-C PD port to charge your device up to 100W.
 - ~15W is used for the adapter's operation USB-C charging port does not support video or data



4. Use USB-A data ports to connect USB devices – 2 x USB 3.2 data up to 10 Gbps each and 1 x USB 2.0. Does not support charging or CD readers, including Apple SuperDrive



5. Connect an RJ45 network cable to the adapter's Gigabit Ethernet port.



Insert microSD or SD cards into the card reader slots.
Support SD/SDHC/SDXC, SD3.0 UHS-1, up to 104MB/S, Capacity up to 2TB (Synchronous use)
