## Introduction

Short push for "play/pause" when playing music (USB card/TF card/Wireless/line-in). In FM mode, press short to automatically seek a station. To quit searching, press the button once more. When a call comes in on a wireless mode phone with a linked phone, press short to answer hands-free, press again to hand up, and press twice to ring up a call. Use a regular Micro USB V8 charging cord to charge the DC 5V slot; When you insert a TF/USB card into the slot, it can decode and play MP3 format audio; In the slot, there's an AUX line: Use the Mini 3.5 head input through external devices; it has 8-hour battery life.

## HOW TO CONNECT

By pushing and holding the Power or Pairing button on your Bluetooth device, you can put it in pairing mode.

- Go to Settings > Bluetooth > Other devices on your iPhone. To connect, tap the device.
- Go to Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth on Android. Select Pair new device, then tap the name of the speaker.

## HOW TO SET UP

- From the top of the screen, swipe down.
- Hold Bluetooth in your hand.
- Pair a new device by tapping it. Check under "Available devices" or press More if you don't see Pair new device. Refresh.
- Select the Bluetooth device you want to associate with your device by tapping its name.
- Any on-screen directions should be followed.

## Frequently Asked Questions

- **What is the best way to tell if your speaker is completely charged?**

If the battery is fully charged, the CHARGE indicator will not light up. The CHARGE indicator may not light up while charging the speaker with the power turned on, depending on the model. The CHARGE indicator will light

up if the battery is being charged when the speaker is switched off.

- **Why isn't my Bluetooth speaker working?**

Both devices' loudness levels should be increased. Make sure the music is playing on your source device. Avoid placing the wireless speaker near metal objects or other devices that could create interference. Make sure there are no other devices connected to the wireless speaker's AUDIO IN port.

- **What's the best way to pair all Bluetooth speakers?**

Users of Android devices must go to Bluetooth Settings and pair Bluetooth headphones or speakers one at a time. After you've connected, go to the right-hand three-dot icon and select Advanced Settings. If it isn't already on, turn on the 'dual audio' option. Users should be able to connect to two devices at the same time as a result of this.

- **What's the deal with my Bluetooth transmitter not connecting?**

If the transmitter is unable to connect to your Bluetooth device, delete the pairing history by pushing the Power Button twice while the transmitter is turned on until the LED indication alternates between red and blue. The transmitter should then be restarted to re-pair.

- **Why is my Bluetooth speaker's blue light flashing?**

A healthy connection can be shown by a constant blinking blue light. The headphones may be in pairing mode if they have a slow pulsing blue light. Blinking red and blue is the most popular light pattern for pairing mode.

- **Why isn't my Bluetooth speaker playing music even if it's connected?**

This is frequently caused by a broken or poor Bluetooth network. To fix this, you'll need to first unpair the device. Restart the speaker and pair it with the Bluetooth device once more. If the problem persists, you'll have to entirely remove the pairing information from your devices.

- **What is the best way to see if my Bluetooth speaker is charging?**

In general, the red light indicates that the device is charging, while the green light indicates that it is fully charged. If the red light is always on (charging for more than 3-5 hours), your speaker's charging circuit is broken or there is no full charge self-stop function.

- **How long does it take to charge a Bluetooth speaker?**

Speakers powered using AC mains power will take approximately 6-8 hours to completely charge. Speakers that are charged by USB take about 3-4 hours to fully charge.

- **Why isn't my Bluetooth speaker producing any sound?**

Make sure your computer's volume isn't set to mute. Close the audio player app and reopen it. Turn your computer's Bluetooth® feature off and then back on again. Remove the speaker from your list of associated Bluetooth devices, then reconnect it.

- **Is Wi-Fi required for a Bluetooth speaker?**

Bluetooth relies on short-range radio waves rather than an internet connection to function. This means that Bluetooth will operate whenever two compatible devices are present – no data plan or even a cellular connection is required.
