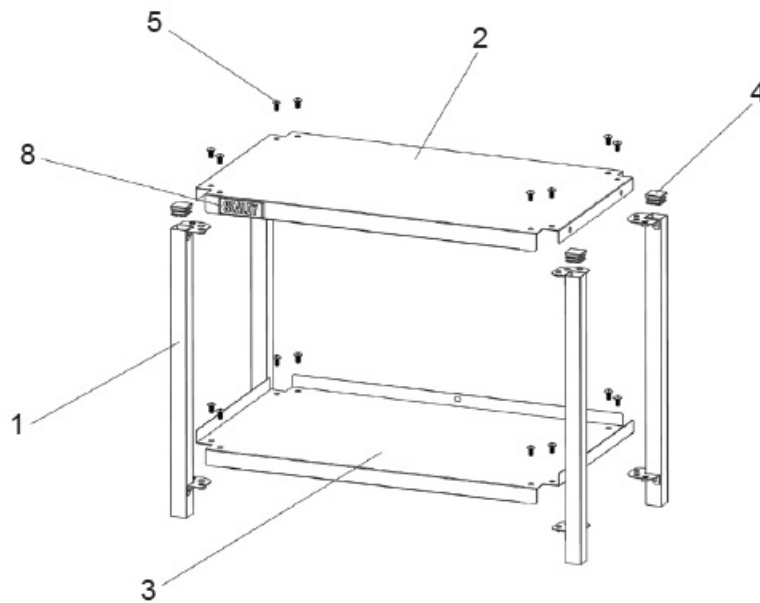

The Sealey modular racking system is finished with a heavy-duty textured powder coat to prevent against rusting. Simply choose your base, middle and top units and push together using nylon connectors to create versatile storage for the workshop, garage, home or office. All drawers have ball-bearing drawer slides for smooth operation and cupboard doors are fitted with spring loaded hinges allowing them to be fitted the side that suits your environment. 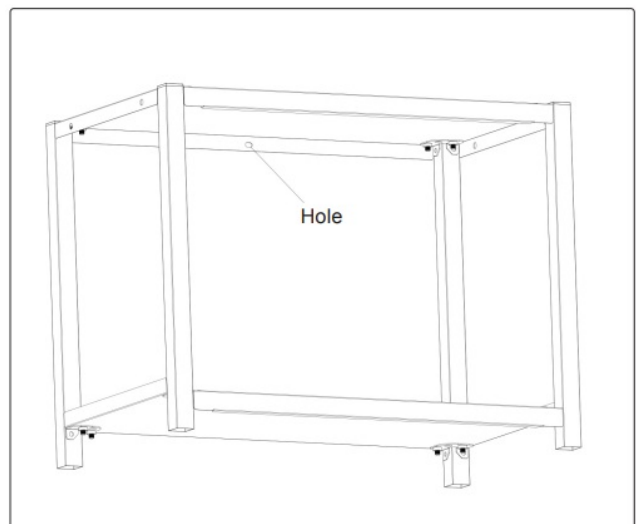
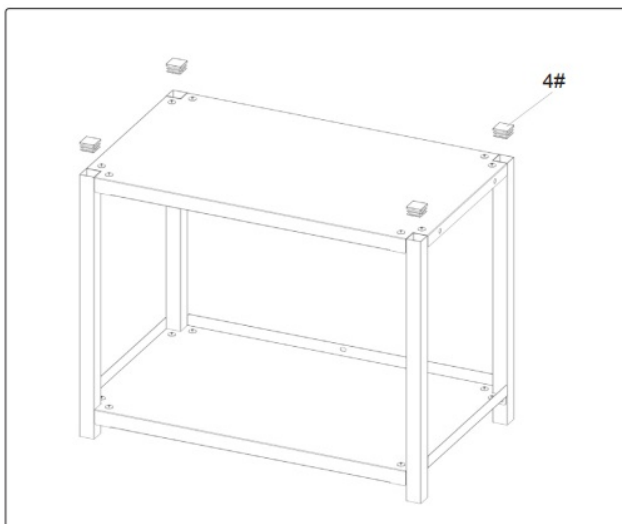


ASSEMBLY

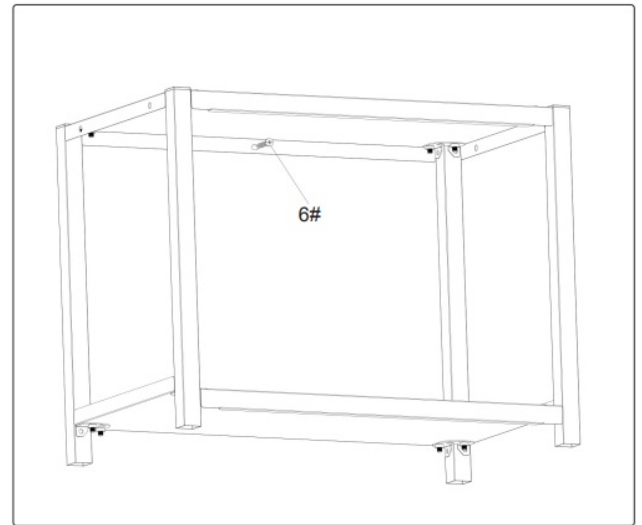
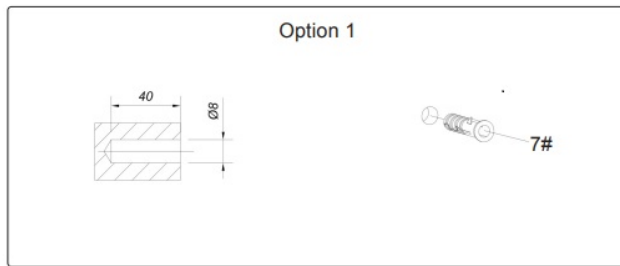
1. Step 1. Assemble the uprights, bottom panel with screws M6*12 as shown.
2. Step 2. Assemble the top panel with screws M6*12.



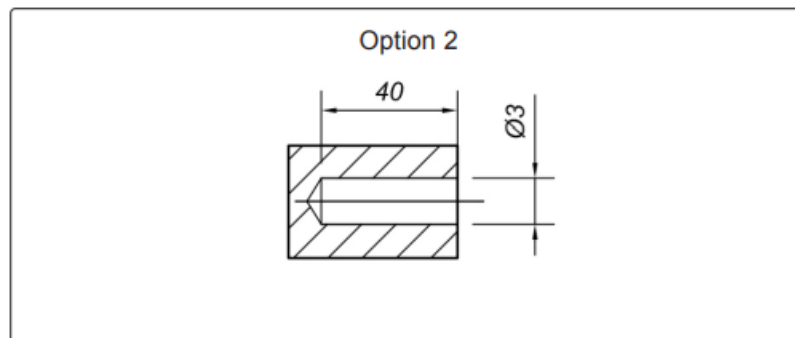
3. Step 3. Insert the plastic end plugs into the uprights.
4. Step 4. To fix on the wall, mark the wall according to the hole which is at the back of top panel, after assembly.



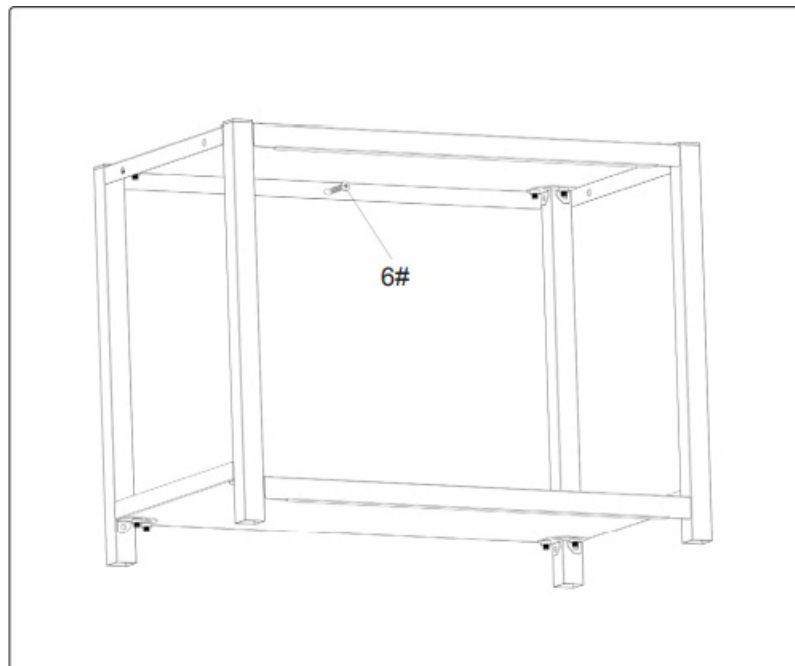
5. Step 5. To fix the cabinet on to the wall. Mark the wall out before drilling the hole, after the wall has been marked drill a hole the size required as illustration, Insert the wall plug 8*40.
6. Step 6. Fix the cabinet to the wall using the self-tapping screw ST4.8*30.



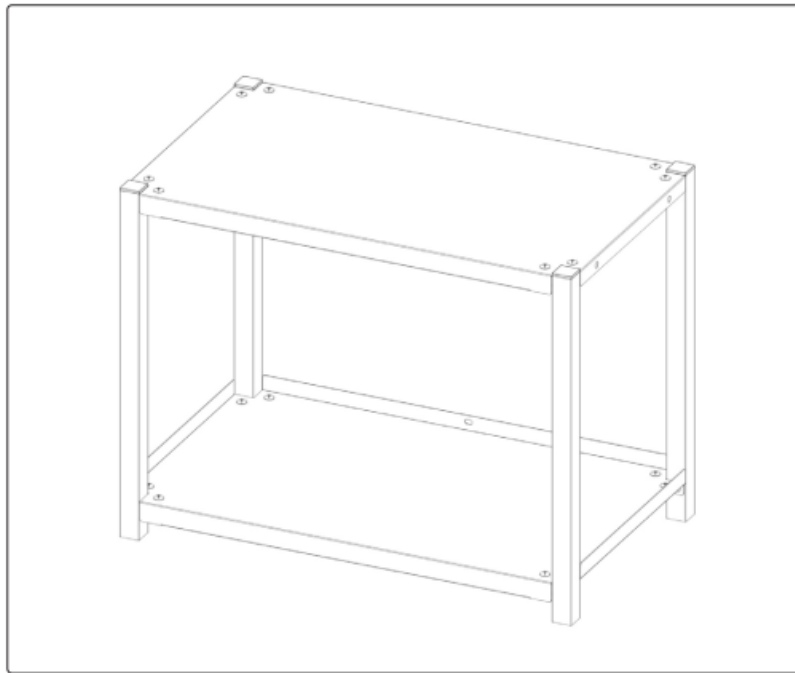
7. Step 7. To fix the cabinet on to a wooden wall. Mark the wall out before drilling. After the wall has been marked, drill a hole the correct size as illustration.



8. Step 8. Fix the cabinet on the wooden wall with the self-tapping screw ST4.8*30, no wall plug is required.



9. Step 9. Assembly completed.
