SAFETY

- ✓ Ensure the torch is fully charged before initial use.
- ✗ **DO NOT** charge in damp conditions.
- ✗ **DO NOT** turn the torch on when it is being charged.
- ✗ **DO NOT** shine directly into your, another person's or an animal's eyes.
- ✗ **DO NOT** allow children to use the torch.
- ✗ **DO NOT** handle or move the torch whilst it is being charged.
- ✗ **DO NOT** use the torch if you suspect that the battery or the torch casing is damaged.
- ✗ **DO NOT** leave battery in a discharged state, recharge battery immediately. Before storage, fully recharge the battery, subsequently recharge the battery at least once every six months of non-use.
- ✗ **DO NOT** attempt to open, disassemble, modify or service the battery pack.
- ✗ **DO NOT** crush, puncture, short external contacts or dispose of in fire or water.
- ✓ Replace only with the battery pack designated for this product.
- ✓ Recycle or dispose of used battery as stipulated by local regulation.
- ✓ If the electrolyte in the cells gets on your skin, thoroughly rinse with water. If it gets in your eyes, rinse thoroughly with cool water and seek immediate medical attention.

INTRODUCTION

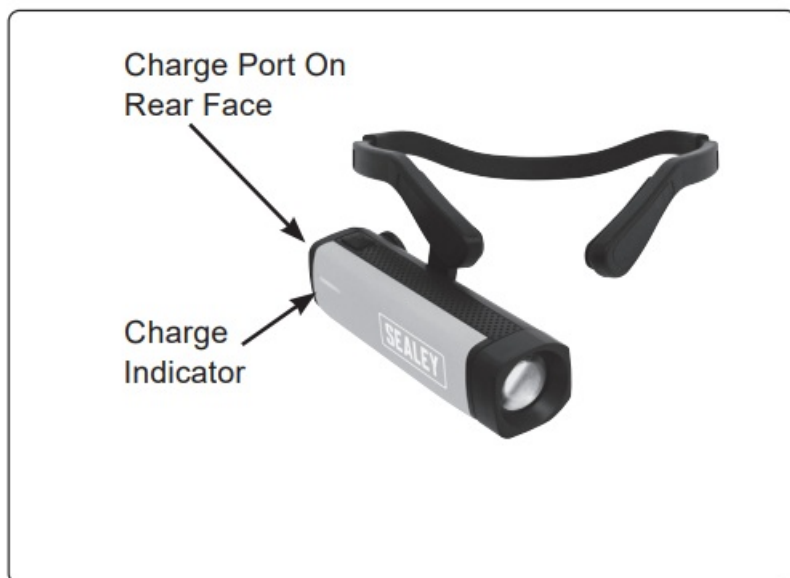
Hands-free 2.5W SMD LED head torch to direct light as required. Two power settings – high and 60% power with an output of 250/150lm.

Green LED charge indicator. Extendable arms with foam pads for added comfort. Supplied with Type-C USB charging cable.

OPERATION



Fit the torch to the head set using the washer, thumb-wheel, cover and screw. Adjust the orientation of the torch to suit.

Pressing the power button once will turn the light on full power, pressing it again will dim the light and pressing a third time will turn the light off.

CHARGING

NOTE: The torch can also be detached from the collar which may make charging more convenient.

Remove USB socket cover on the torch.

Connect the USB lead to the port on the end of the battery pack and the other end to a USB power socket. Turn on the power supply.

Switch off power supply, remove charging lead and replace socket cover on battery pack.

The charge indicator (green LED) on the side of the torch will flash to show the unit is charging and has charge.



ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION
