
## **Remote Control**




## Start/Stop Cleaning



- After the robot adsorbs successfully, short press "On/OFF" button on the robot or press "on the remote control to start automatic cleaning.\
- The robot default cleaning mode is Z path.
- Press "to start /stop cleaning
- " N " for vertical glass. Clean with "N" path



- In the status of "Stop", press " button to control the cleaning direction of the robot, and to switch cleaning path.
- $\bullet$   $\begin{tabular}{c} \end{tabular}$  for horizontal glass Clean with "Z" path
