






2.4G Wireless Connection


1. Open the battery cover of the keyboard



2. Put in the battery (please check the positive and negative poles of the battery before inserting)




3. Turn on the power switch




- 4. Insert batteries for the mouse. (please check the positive and negative poles of the battery before inserting)
