

DUST CUP/FILTER/ACCESSORIES




LITHIUM-ION BATTERY







- 1. Make sure to switch the unit into the "O" position to power off before charging.
- 2. Plug the USB-C end of the charging cord into the port on the handle. Plug the USB end of the charging cord into a compatible USB outlet cube or adaptor (not included) and plug into a wall outlet.

NOTE: Lithium-ion battery takes approximately 6 hours to charge completely.

USING YOUR SHARK*® VACUUM





- 1. Slide the switch into "I" position to power on.
- 2. Run the nozzle over the surface to be cleaned.
- 3. To empty the dust cup, first slide the switch into "0 position to power off. Then press the dust cup release button on the back of the hand vac and pull off the dust cup.
- 4. Remove the filter from the dust cup by pulling the tab in the center and then empty the debris into the trash.
- 5. Once debris is emptied, place the filter back in place and reattach the dust cup.



TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution			
The vacuum wil I not operate	Battery needs to be recharged. Lithium-ion battery takes approxima tely 6 hours to charge completely. Try using a different electrical outlet to charge.			
Vacuum will not pick up or sucti on is weak	Dust cup is full. Empty the dust cup. The filter needs to be cleaned or replaced. Vacuum needs to be recharged.			
Dust is escapin g from the vacu um	Empty the dust cup. The filter may be installed incorrectly. Remove t he filter, then reinstall it correctly. Check the filter for holes or punctures. The filter will need to be replaced if there is a hole or puncture. An obstruction may be blocking the dust cup lid, keeping it from clos ing correctly. Clear any obstructions and ensure the lid is completely closed.			

BATTERY INDICATOR

Pulsing Light	Low Batt ery	If the power switch is in the (I) position but the power doe sn't turn on and the battery indicator light on the hand va c is pulsing, this means the battery power is too low. Slid e the power switch to the (0) position and charge the batt ery before using the vacuum.
Pulsing Light (while plugged in)	Vacuum C harging	To charge the vacuum, connect charging cord to unit and plug into wall outlet. The light will turn off when the unit is fully charged.
No Light	Fully Cha rged	When the vacuum is fully charged, the indicator light will t urn off. (It takes approximately 6 hours for a full charge).



MAINTENANCE

CLEANING THE DUST CUP




- 1. Slide the switch to the "O" position to power off. Press the dust cup release button and pull out the dust cup.
- 2. Carefully take the filter frame out of the dust cup and remove the filter.





- 3. Empty the dust cup into the trash.
- 4. Hand-rinse the filter in cold water and let it air-dry for at least 24 hours before reinstalling. Air-dry only. DO NOT use a hair dryer or clothes dryer.





To clean the interior of the dust cup, rinse it with water. Place it on its side with the lid open to air-dry for at least 24-48 hours before reinstalling.

5. When the filter is dry, reinstall into the dust cup, then reattach the dust cup to the main body.

DO NOT wash any parts or accessories in a dishwasher.

NOTE: For best results, replace the filter every 6 to 9 months.
