



#### WHAT TO EXPECT


As your robot learns your home, you may need to make some small adjustments to optimize performance.






For a constant state of clean<sup>TM</sup>, set up a cleaning sche dule in the app.

While your robot is cleaning, do not pick it up and mov e it, or move the charging dock—this will impact the ro bot's ability to map your home.






During the first few weeks of use, the dust bin will nee d to be emptied frequently. Empty debris and dust into trash


Remove any debris buildup between the filter and the plastic shield.


For best results, run your robot in well-lit conditions. If you run your robot at night, keep the lights on in the ar eas to be cleaned.



Your robot can easily climb over most thresholds, but if one is higher than 7/8ths of an inch, block it off with a B otBoundary® strip.


### **SETUP**





- · Remove protective film from robot and dock.
- Attach the side brushes to the posts on the bottom of the robot. The side brushes are located in the red packaging.
- Turn on the power by pressing the button on the side of the robot to the (I) ON position.

Find a **permanent** location for the dock in a central ar ea with a strong Wi-Fi signal. **Remove any objects** th at are closer than 3 ft. from either side of the dock, or c loser than 5 ft. from the front. Place the dock with its b ack against the wall, and connect the charging cord to the back. The **Indicator Light** will illuminate green wh en the dock has power.






Place robot on dock to charge for 6 hours. Power but ton must be in the (I) ON position and the robot mus t be aligned correctly, with its FRONT side against the dock. When charging begins, the robot will BEEP and the DOCK light will turn **BLUE**.

#### **OPTIMIZING YOUR HOME FOR CLEANING**





Clear cords and remove small objects like toys, clothin g, or drapes from floors. Open interior doors in rooms you want your robot to clean.


Use the BotBoundary® strip included in the box to kee p your robot out of the areas you would like it to avoid:


- Near power cords or phone chargers.
- In front of thresholds higher than 7/8ths of an inch.

Restart your phone Reboot your robot

• Press the power button on the sid e of the robot to the (O) OFF positio n. Wait 10 seconds, then press it to the (I) ON position.

Reboot your router

 Unplug the router power cable for 30 seconds, then plug it back in. All ow several minutes for your router t o reboot completely.
