



# Inserting the batteries




Place batteries with their terminals corresponding to the (+) and (-) indications in the battery compartment.



# Attaching the stand



- 1. Do not lay the Monitor screen down.
- 2. To protect the screen, do not remove the screen protector pad (cardboard) until installation is complete.
- Always work with two or more people.Do not hold the four corners of the Monitor.







# **Important Safety Precautions**

- Stand base must be attached to prevent the Monitor set from falling down and cause injuries.
- Cleaning Unplug the AC cord from the AC outlet before cleaning the product. Use a soft damp cloth to clean
  the product. Do not use liquid cleaners, aerosol cleaners or chemical cloth to clean it, as such materials may
  damage the product.
- Water and moisture Do not use the product near water, such as bathtub, washbasin, kitchen sink, laundry tub, swimming pool and in a wet basement.
- Do not place vases or any other water-fi lled containers on this product.
   The water may spill onto the product causing fi re or electric shock.
- Stand Do not place the product on an unstable cart, stand, tripod or table. Doing so can cause the product to fall, resulting in serious personal injuries as well as damage to the product. Use only a cart, stand, tripod, bracket or table recommended by the manufacturer or sold with the product. When mounting the product on a wall, be sure to follow the manufacturer's instructions. Use only the mounting hardware recommended by the manufacturer.

- When relocating the product placed on a cart, it must be moved with utmost care. Sudden stops, excessive force and uneven fl oor surface can cause the product to fall from the cart.
- Ventilation The vents and other openings in the cabinet are designed for ventilation. Do not cover or block these vents and openings since insufficient ventilation can cause overheating and/or shorten the life of the product. - The LCD panel used in this product is made of glass. Therefore, it can break when the product is struck forcefully or with a sharp object. If the LCD panel is broken, be careful not to be injured by broken glass.
- Heat sources Keep the product away from heat sources such as radiators, heaters, stoves and other heatgenerating products (including amplifiers).
- To prevent fi re, never place any type of candle or naked fl ames on the top or near the Monitor set.
- To prevent fi re or shock hazard, do not place the AC power cord under the Monitor set or other heavy items.
- Do not place heavy objects on this product or stand on it. Doing so could cause injury if the product overturns. Take special care near children and pets.
- The LCD panel is made with extremely high precision technology, and has 99.99% or more effective pixels. The 0.01% or less missing pixels or those that are always lit is not a malfunction.
  - Precautions when transporting the Monitor
  - When transporting the Monitor, never carry it by holding or otherwise putting pressure onto the display. Be sure to always carry the Monitor by two people holding it with two hands one hand on each side of the Monitor.
- Do not display a still picture for a long time, as this could cause an afterimage to remain.
- Install the product on the place where the AC cord can be unplugged easily from the AC outlet or from the AC INPUT terminal on the rear of the product.
  - Stability Hazard
- A Monitor set may fall, causing serious personal injury or death. Many injuries, particularly to children, can be avoided by taking simple precautions such as:
  - ALWAYS use cabinets or stands or mounting methods recommended by the manufacturer of the Monitor set.
  - ALWAYS use furniture that can safely support the Monitor set.
  - ALWAYS ensure the Monitor set is not overhanging the edge of the supporting furniture.

- Do not install the Monitor in a location in which it will be subject to water drops such as underneath an air

conditioning unit or in the vicinity of a humidifi er.

- Water drops falling onto the Monitor and water entering inside it may result in fi re, electric shock, or malfunctions.
- We recommend that you install the Monitor at least 1m away from the outlet of an air conditioner.

#### Initial installation


Follow the steps below one by one when using the Monitor for the first time. Some steps may not be necessary depending on your Monitor installation and connection.

- 1. Plug the AC cord into the AC inlet of the main unit.
  - Plug the AC cord into the AC outlet.
  - Place the Monitor close to the AC outlet, and keep the power plug within reach.
- 2. Press (JOG-KEY) on the Monitor.
- 3. Run the initial installation.
  - Follow the guide on the Monitor screen to set the settings.



# **Troubleshooting**

The problems described below are not always caused by malfunctions. Check the Monitor again before having the Monitor serviced.

	Problem		Possible Solution
•	No power.	•	Check if you pressed (POWER) on the remote control unit. Is the AC cord disconnected? Has the power been turned on?
•	Remote control unit does no t operate.	•	Are batteries inserted with polarity ( + , — ) aligned?
•	No picture.	•	Is connection to other components correct?
•	No sound.	•	Is connection to other components correct?

#### Clearing the password

If you forget the password, clear the password using the following procedure.

- 1. From the Dashboard, select "Settings" > "System" > "About" > "Reset" > "Factory reset", and then press (ENTER)/OK.
- 2. When you perform a reset, the Monitor will be returned to the factory preset values, and you need to set the password again.

- The default PIN is "1234".


