





## **Network Setup**


Network link method Ethernet has the highest priority, wifi has the second highest priority, 1-1 . WIFI network link

#### 1. wifi link


Tap the [HOME] button after entering the system to enter the secondary interface



• Click [Settings] to enter the settings interface





• Turn on the WIFI.



• Once open, click on the name of the WIFI you want to link to




• If you need to set the static IP of WIFI, i.e. check "Advanced Options" and select Static for IP setting.




#### WIFI Status View

Click on the Settings icon on the right after linking to WIFI




After entering, click "Advanced" to view the MAC address and IP of WIFI.

#### 1. Link Ethernet

Insert the cable into the Ethernet port, the system will be automatically linked to the network, no need to do any operation, click [Ethernet], you can see the status of the Ethernet, MAC address, IP address, physical address







Click [Ethernet mode Ethernet ip mode], you can set the Ethernet mode, including static DHCP, dynamic STATIC

## **Bluetooth Setup**


Click [Settings] - [Connected Devices] to make settings

Click on [Settings] - [Display] to set up




Adjustable LVDS (VBO), EDP screen brightness




## **Sound Settings**

Click [Settings] – [System] – [Language and Input Method] settings to set the language and input method





Click [Settings] – [System] – [Date and Time]




## **Backup & Reset**



### **Software Uninstallation & Installation**


## 1. Unloading

The left mouse button longan or touch the finger longan need to uninstall the program, and then drag to the location of the [remove] can be



#### 2. Installation

Click [Explorer], select the file with APK extension to install.






## Files in removable storage

Click [Explorer] and see the following interface



If you want to move a file, click [Multi-Select], select the file to be moved, the file name of the selected file will turn yellow, and then click [Edit].



Click [Edit] after the pop-up dialog box, click [Move], and then move the selected file to the specified location



Let's take copy as an example, after clicking Copy, then find the target folder we need to copy to, open the folder (we select the DCIM folder here), right-click the pop-up dialog box, select [Paste], you can complete the copy.
