Frequently Asked Questions

When my wireless earphones are fully charged, how do I know?

When your earbuds are plugged in and charging, the charging case will blink red. The LED will stop flashing and become solid red once fully charged.

· How many times can wireless earphones be recharged?

Lithium-ion batteries are used in most earphones, and they stop charging once they reach 100 percent charge. So, no, you won't be able to overcharge your earbuds by leaving them plugged in for long periods of time; leaving your earbuds plugged in for long periods of time will have no effect on the battery's health.

· Is it possible to use the earbuds separately or do they have to be used together?

You can use them separately; the casing is the key. When you remove them from the case, they both turn on and connect to each other before searching for a device. If you merely remove one earphone from the case, it checks for the other one before looking for a device.

· Should I keep my earbuds on all the time just in case?

Lithium-ion batteries are used in almost all wireless earbuds, and they are engineered to stop charging once they are fully charged. Your earphones will be protected from harsh temperatures, moisture, and even dust if you keep them in the case.

Without a charger, how do you charge wireless earbuds?

You may charge wireless earphones using a power bank or by plugging them into laptops or desktops. The USB cord can be used to connect the earbuds to the laptop.

When my earbud case flashes red, what does it mean?

The Problem. If you notice a red light on your AirPod case, it means your battery is low. While the AirPods are not inside the case, an amber or red light on the case indicates that it needs to be charged.

Is it possible to charge wireless earphones without a case?

Unfortunately, because the earbuds cannot be charged without a case, there is no other choice in these situations than to purchase a replacement case.

How long does it take to charge wireless earbuds?

Most wireless over-ear headphone batteries take 2 to 5 hours to completely charge on average. Wireless inear headphone batteries, on the other hand, can take 1 to 3 hours to fully charge and can last up to 20 hours before needing to be recharged.

Is it acceptable to leave earbuds in their charging case?

Never keep your earbuds or charging case plugged in for an extended period of time. Unplug the cable once they're fully charged.

Is it possible to overcharge your earbuds?

Overcharging your wireless earphones will have no effect on the gadget. There was a time when nickel-based batteries were used in the majority of electronic devices, and their lifespan was shortened owing to overcharging. Overcharging has little effect on lithium-ion batteries, which are presently the most common type.
