



Projector component and functions




- Do not place objects within 20cm near the heat dissipation holes.





Remote control

PS:

Please pair the Bluetooth remote control first to facilitate the use of the remote control and mouse functions.

- 1. After turning on the machine, press the V- and F- buttons on the remote control at the same time, and the remote control indicator light will enter a flashing state.
- 2. Use the remote control to operate the projector to enter the setting interface and enter the Bluetooth interface to search.
- 3. Search for the name: BT Keyboard, and click Connect. It can be used after the connection is successful.
- 4. If you cannot search for the relevant name, please repeat steps 1 and 2.
