



1.2 Intended Use

This device is intended for professional use as a 3-phase power distribution unit in theaters, entertainment facilities, public venues, and similar. It is suitable only for indoor use. This device is not suitable for households and residential buildings.

This device is designed for use in environment B.

Any other use, not mentioned under intended use, is regarded as non-intended and incorrect use.

2.1 Warnings and Safety Instructions



Electric shock caused by dangerous voltage inside

- Do not open the device or remove any covers.
- Do not operate the device if the covers or the housing are open. Before operation, check if the housing is firmly closed and all screws are tightly fastened.

Disconnect the device from electrical power supply before service and maintenance.



Electric shock caused by short-circuit
This device falls under IEC protection class I.

- Make sure that the device is electrically connected to ground (earth). Connect the device only to a socket-outlet with ground (earth) connection.
- Make sure that the power source is equipped with a residual-current device.
- Do not cover the ground (earth) connection.
- Do not bypass the thermostatic switch or fuses.
- Do not let the power cable come into contact with other cables. Handle the power cable and all connections with the mains with caution.
- Do not modify, bend, mechanically strain, put pressure on, pull or heat up the power cable.
- Make sure that the power cable is not crimped or damaged. Examine the power cable periodically for any defects.
- Do not immerse the device in water or other liquids. Do not install the device in a location where flooding may
 occur.



Power supply

Before connecting the device to the power supply, make sure that the current, voltage and frequency match the input voltage, current and frequency specified on the information label on the device.

Make sure that the cross-sectional area of the extension cords and power cables is sufficient for the required power consumption of the device.



- Do not shake the device. Avoid brute force when installing or operating the device.
- If the device is dropped or struck, disconnect the device from the electrical power supply immediately.
- If the device is exposed to extreme temperature variations (e.g. after transportation), do not switch it on immediately. Let the device reach room temperature before switching it on, otherwise it may be damaged by the formed condensation.
- If the device fails to work properly, discontinue the use immediately.



Description of the Device

The Powersplit 32 True1 is a 3-phase power distribution unit. It has 6 Power Pro True outputs (divided over 3 phases) a 5-pin CEE input and a 5-pin CEE output. The maximum allowed current load is 32 A per phase. The maximum allowed current load per output is 16 A.






Installation

4.1 Safety Instructions for Installation



WARNING

Incorrect installation can cause serious injuries and damage of property.

Installation must be carried out only by instructed or skilled persons.

Follow all applicable European, national and local safety regulations concerning electrical installations.



Make sure there is enough space for ventilation around the device.

Installation Site Requirements

- The device must be installed only indoors.
- The device can be mounted to a truss or other rigging structure in any orientation.
- The maximum ambient temperature ta = 60 °C must never be exceeded.
- The relative humidity must not exceed 50 % with an ambient temperature of 60 °C.


4.3 Rigging

The device can be positioned on a flat surface or mounted to a truss or other rigging structure in any orientation. Make sure that all loads are within the pre-determined limits of the supporting structure.



Restrict the access under the work area during rigging and/or derigging. To mount the device, follow the steps below:

1. Install the clamp, as shown in Fig. 05. Make sure that the clamp is suitable for attaching the device to a truss.



- 2. Attach the device to the supporting structure. Make sure that the device cannot move freely.
- 3. Secure the device with a secondary suspension, for example a safety cable. Make sure that the secondary suspension can hold 10 times the weight of the device. If possible, the secondary suspension should be attached to a supporting structure independent of the primary suspension. Put the safety cable through the handle, as shown in Fig. 05.

4.4 Connecting to Power Supply



DANGER

Electric shock caused by short-circuit


The device accepts AC mains power at 400 V and 50 Hz. Do not supply power at any other voltage or frequency to the device.

This device falls under IEC protection class I. Make sure that the device is always electrically connected to the ground (earth).

Before connecting the device to the socket-outlet:

- Make sure that the power supply matches the input voltage specified on the information label on the device.
- Make sure that the socket-outlet has ground (earth) connection.
- Make sure that the power source is equipped with a residual-current device.
 Connect the device to the socket-outlet with a 3 x 32 A CEE H07RN-F cable.

Connect all cables before supplying power.

Disconnect power supply before connecting or disconnecting cables.

Power supply

Before connecting the device to the power supply, make sure that the current, voltage and frequency match the input voltage, current and frequency specified on the information label on the device.

Do not use the circuit breakers as an on/off switch, to switch on the devices connected to the outputs.

Switch these devices on only after you have set all the circuit breakers to ON position.

Start-up

- 1. Connect the power supply to the 32 A 5-pin CEE connector IN (04).
- 2. Move the CH1-CH6 main circuit breakers (02) to ON position.
- 3. Connect external devices to the 6 x Power Pro True L1-L3 connectors OUT (03).
- 4. Connect other 3-phase power distribution units to the 32 A 5-pin CEE connector OUT (07).
- 5. Switch on the external devices.

Troubleshooting

This troubleshooting guide contains solutions to problems which can be carried out by an ordinary person. The

device does not contain user-serviceable parts.

Unauthorized modifications to the device will render the warranty void. Such modifications may result in injuries and material damage.

Refer servicing to instructed or skilled persons. Contact your Highlite International dealer in case the solution is not described in the table.

7.2 Preventive Maintenance



Attention

Before use, examine the device visually for any defects.

Make sure that:

- All screws used for installing the device or parts of the device are tightly fastened and are not corroded.
- There are no deformations on housings, fixations and installation points.
- The power cables are not damaged and do not show any material fatigue.

Basic Cleaning Instructions

To clean the device, follow the steps below:

- 1. Disconnect the device from the electrical power supply.
- 2. Allow the device to cool down for 5 minutes.
- 3. Clean the device with a soft, lint-free cloth.



- Do not immerse the device in liquid.
- · Do not use alcohol or solvents.

Corrective Maintenance

The device does not contain user-serviceable parts. Do not open the device and do not modify the device. Refer repairs and servicing to instructed or skilled persons. Contact your Highlite International dealer for more information.

Deinstallation, Transportation and Storage

- Disconnect power supply before deinstallation.
- Use the original packaging to transport the device, if possible.
- Clean the device before storing. Follow the cleaning instructions in chapter 7.2.1. Basic Cleaning Instructions on page 13.
- Store the device in the original packaging, if possible.
