Introduction

Because of the built-in rechargeable battery, you may sing or start a karaoke party anywhere you go with this karaoke machine. Its portability, lightweight design, and handy carry handle make it the perfect karaoke machine for kids who want to perform. There is no end to your options when it comes to music. One of the two integrated karaoke mic can be used to sing along to your own favorite karaoke songs while the other is connected to your mobile device through Bluetooth, Aux, or a pre-loaded USB.

If you want to hold a karaoke party, you can combine your smart TG with a Bluetooth speaker to get the party started by having your guests see the lyrics from their favorite streaming service on a large screen as they sing along. When turned on, the built-in LED lights sync up with the music, and the speech effects are fantastic for boosting self-esteem and having some fun.

It comes with two speakers and two microphones. The speakers are capable of producing clear sound which is quite loud, loud enough to fill the entire room. The two microphones are perfect for duets. The karaoke system has appealing LED lights. It offers a number of connectivity methods including Bluetooth or Aux connection.

What's in the Box?

- 1 x USB power cable
- 1 x AUX input audio cable
- 2 x Microphone

How to charge the SingCube

Connect one end of the USB power cord to the DC input jack on the speaker's back after fully unwinding the USB power wire. Connect the other end to a PC USB port or USB power supply. When charging is occurring, the chargeindicator LED will turn red. Before using, charge the speaker for at least 4 hours. The charge indication LED will turn off when the speaker is fully charged.

Switching the SingCube On/Off

To turn on the speaker, press the on/off switch at the back of the device. The Bluetooth indicator will turn blue and there will be a chirp to let you know the speaker is looking for a Bluetooth audio device. To turn off a speaker, press the speaker's on/off button at the back.

Bluetooth Operation

It is a top-notch Bluetooth speaker, the SingCube. A Bluetooth-enabled device, such as a mobile phone or tablet, can stream music to the SingCube Speaker. Select "SC01" from the list of Bluetooth devices detected using your smartphone or another Bluetooth-enabled device. After that, the Bluetooth device should establish a connection with the speaker, and a continuous blue status light will indicate a successful connection.

Song Control

- To alternatively play and pause the song, press the PLAY/PAUSE button.
- To return to the track's beginning, select the PREVIOUS track button. To choose the previous track, press twice.
- To play the next track, click the NEXT track button.

Volume Control

There are two ways to change the output volume:

- Changing the volume on a Bluetooth device, such as a mobile phone, tablet computer, iPad, etc.
- Pressing the VOL- or VOL+ buttons on the speaker.

Switching the Lightshow On/off

The light show can be turned on or off by pressing and holding the MODE button.

Using the Microphone

You can use the inbuilt microphone or microphones to sing along to any song being played via the speaker. Slide the microphone power switch to the on position and plug the microphone into the speaker's top-mounted microphone connectors. As needed, alter the echo control and microphone volume. NOTE: Do not tap or bang the microphone as this can harm both the microphone and speaker. Instead, move farther away from the speaker or turn down the music or microphone volume until the howling ceases. Avoid twisting or straining the microphone cable, and avoid swinging the microphone by the cord, as doing so will result in permanent damage.

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I connect to karaoke Bluetooth?

Your karaoke system's Bluetooth discovery mode on. Search for devices in the Bluetooth section of your TV's settings after that. Your karaoke machine will appear in the list of choices; simply select it and tap pair (or connect to this device) to link it to your TV.

Can I connect karaoke mic to Bluetooth speaker?

Yes, using Bluetooth or an audio cord, it is simple to pair with karaoke machines.

How do I connect a Bluetooth microphone to my iPhone?

Go to Bluetooth under Settings on your phone. Your device should be shown under "OTHER DEVICES" at the bottom; choose it and connect. Swipe down from the top of the screen on an Android device, tap and hold Bluetooth, then select the keyboard from the list of devices to link.

How does a Bluetooth karaoke machine work?

It functions by establishing a Bluetooth or AUX lead connection with a smart device, such as a tablet or smartphone. You can then access a karaoke app or YouTube to find a karaoke track on your smart device. You then use your smart device as the screen and your microphone to listen to both your singing and the accompaniment.

How does Bluetooth mic work?

Through their built-in transmitters, wireless microphones broadcast their output signals wirelessly. The audio signal from the microphone will be converted by the transmitter into a carrier signal and wirelessly transmitted to the receiver. The original mic signal for the associated mic input will then be decoded by the receiver.

Why is my karaoke machine not working?

Make sure the power cord is plugged in and connected to the machine if the machine doesn't receive electricity when the power switch is turned on. If you're using battery power, make sure the batteries are there and in good condition in the battery compartment.

How do I connect my Bluetooth microphone to my android?

After turning on your Bluetooth headset, right-click the desktop's sound icon and select Open Sound from the menu that appears. If you click on Input, the input device will be listed in the drop-down menu. A Bluetooth microphone option will appear in the dropdown.
