




Device Overview



Device Status Lights


Powering Up	(30 Sec.)
Powering Down	(30 Sec.)
RF Event Trigger	
Device Reset	(30 Sec.)
Firmware update	(until complete)
*Success Indicator, Solid LED	(5 Sec.)
*Failure Indicator, Solid LED	(5 Sec.)




While unit is ON and not being triggered the status LED will flash every 5 seconds:

Last transmission was successful	(Rapid flash once)
Last transmission failed	(Rapid flash once)
Unit currently paused	(Rapid flash once)

Activate Hub




Scan the unique QR code located on the back of the device and follow all in-app instructions to finish activating your Hub.




NOTE: QR code and serial number can also be found on the original packaging.

Start-Up Operation



- 1. Power ON the Hub by pressing and holding the function button; release when the GREEN status LED starts blinking.
- 2. Upon successful completion of the power ON process an alert will be sent to the Skyhawk CE application.

Shutdown Operation



- 1. Power OFF the Hub by pressing and holding the function button; release when the RED status LED starts blinking.
- 2. Upon successful completion of the power OFF process an alert will be sent to the Skyhawk CE application.

Resetting Hub


(Factory Default Setting)

1	Press & Hold Function Button	The second secon
2	Keep Holding Function Button	status Press and hold button until LED sequence changes to rap id blinking red
3	Release Function Button	(10+ seconds) status
4	Startup Operation Begins	status

Battery Replacement

IMPORTANT: Always replace batteries with 3 new and identical name-brand AA lithium batteries.

1	Unscrew/Open Hub Case	1
2	Remove Batteries
