

User interface comparison

SMART Remote Management

When you first sign in to SMART Remote Management, a window appears. This window includes information about the new user interface and allows you to switch to it.

The new use interface is faster, more secure, and provides new features and capabilities.

Groups	You can find groups by clicking Groups in the D evices view.	You can find groups in the Groups view.
Filters	You can create and save filters using the Filter s button in the Devices view. You can also filter the OS, Policy-Kiosk, and Ta gs columns.	You can create and save filters by clicking FILTER S & GROUPS in the Devices view.
Triggers	Triggers are referred to as "Schedulers and trig gers" in the new user interface.	Triggers are referred to as "Triggers" in the existing user interface.
