## **Attaching the Back Button Attachment**

- 1. Hold the back button attachment with your thumb behind the stereo headset plug.
- 2. With the attachment's stereo headset plug and the controller's stereo headset jack aligned, firmly push the attachment toward the controller to insert. Do not push sideways or from the top or bottom of the attachment.

## Powering up

- 1. Press the p (PS) button to turn on your controller.
- 2. Click the screen button on the attachment. The default profile (P1) appears on the screen.

#### **Customizing Profiles**

You can save up to 3 different profiles (button assignments).

#### The default profiles are as follows:

- J: P1
- K: P2
- L: P3

#### To customize a profile:

- 1. Hold the screen button down for 1 second to enter programming mode. The profile number in the centre of the screen flashes to indicate programming mode.
- 2. Press the back buttons to select from among the available button assignments. Press and hold a back button to scroll through the possible assignments for that back button.
- 3. Click the screen button once to exit programming mode and save your profile.

#### **Starting Over**

If you want to reset your attachment to the default profiles:

- 1. Press and hold the left back button, right back button, and screen button at the same time.
- 2. Once the reset icon appears on the screen, continue to hold for 5 seconds.
- 3. When HJKL appears, the reset is done.

## · How many profiles can I save?

You can save up to 3 different profiles.

#### How do I enter programming mode?

Hold the screen button down for 1 second to enter programming mode. The profile number in the centre of the screen will flash to indicate programming mode.

#### · How do I customize a profile?

Press the back buttons to select from among the available button assignments. Press and hold a back button to scroll through the possible assignments for that back button. Click the screen button once to exit programming mode and save your profile.

#### · How do I reset the attachment to default profiles?

Press and hold the left back button, right back button, and screen button at the same time. Once the reset icon appears on the screen, continue to hold for 5 seconds. When HJKL appears, the reset is done.






## **Getting started**


- The DUALSHOCK®4 back button attachment adds two extra buttons to the back of your
- DUALSHOCK®4 wireless controller, giving you two more programmable buttons for extra control in your games.
- You can program these extra buttons, allowing you to customize your set-up and get the edge with important controls at your fingertips. Each saved assignment is called a profile.

#### Before connecting:

- Turn off your controller before attaching the product to your DUALSHOCK®4 wireless controller to ensure a proper connection.
- Use this product only with a DUALSHOCK®4 wireless controller.
- 1. Hold the back button attachment with your thumb behind the stereo headset plug.




2. With the attachment's stereo headset plug and the controller's stereo headset jack aligned, firmly push the attachment toward the controller to insert.



Don't push sideways or from the top or bottom of the attachment.

## Powering up








## Customize a profile


Hold the screen button down for 1 second to enter programming mode.
The profile number in the centre of the screen flashes to let you know you're in programming mode.



2. Press the back buttons to select from among the available button assignments. Press and hold a back button to scroll through the possible assignments for that back button.



3. Click the screen button once to exit programming mode and save your profile.




If you want to customize another profile, hold the screen button down for 1 second to enter programming mode. Then, click twice to program the next profile.

#### Notes:

- In programming mode, the screen turns itself off after 10 seconds of inactivity. When not in programming mode, the screen turns itself off after 3 seconds of inactivity.
- Any customized button assignments made within PS4™ system settings also apply to the attachment.
- Oindicates that no button is assigned. When you assign both back buttons in a profile to O, that profile is hidden when not in programming mode.

## Starting over

If you want to reset your attachment to the default profiles, press and hold the left-back button, right-back button, and screen button at the same time. Once the reset  $\circ$  icon appears on the screen, continue to hold for 5 seconds. When  $\triangle O \times \square$  HJKL appears, the reset is done.
