### IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Read all safety and operating instructions before using this product.
- 2. All safety and operating instructions should be kept for future reference.
- 3. Read and understand all warnings listed on the operating instructions.
- 4. Follow all operating instructions to operate this product.
- 5. This product should not be used near water, i.e. Bathtub, sink, swimming pool, web basement etc.
- 6. Only use dry cloth to clean this product.
- 7. Do not block any ventilation openings, it should not be placed flat against a wall or placed in a built-in enclosure that will impede the flow of cooling air.
- 8. Do not install this product near any heat sources, such as, radiators, heat registers, stove or other apparatus (including heat producing amplifiers) that produce heat.
- 9. Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized or grounding-type plug. A polarized plug has two blades with one wider than the other. 
- 13. Unplug this apparatus during lightning storms or when unused for long periods of time.





### Installation

### 1. Standard Wall Mount


(With the U bracket included in the package)




- 1. STEP 1: Remove the M6 and M8 locating inserts from the cabinet as shown in Fig. 1
- 2. STEP 2: Align the U bracket with the screw holes and use the included M8x25 machine screws to fix it to both side on the cabinet
- 3. STEP 3: Insert the included M6x1 8 machine screws through the curved slots on the U bracket into the screw holes but do not tighten them.
- 4. STEP 4: Adjust the U bracket to your desired angle and then tighten the M6x1 8 screws on both side.
