Description of Parts



Item	Function	Operation	
1	LED indicator	Blue light blinks on Bluetooth pairing mode, and stays on when Bluetooth is paired successfully.	
2	Power / LED light button	To turn ON/OFF the speaker/To adjust the warm white LED light brightness, or change different color light mode .	
3	PREV / Volume decrease (–)	A short press will skip backward to the previous track and a long press will decrease the volume.	
4	► Phone button	Play/pause button – A short press will pause or restart the mus ic. Phone button – Answer / reject / end call / redial last number. For Hands-Free Conversation	
5	NEXT / Volume increase (+)	A short press will skip forward to the next track, and a long pre ss will increase the volume level.	
6	Mode button	Switching mode of operation	
7	Built-in Mic	For Hands-Free Conversation	
8	LED charge indicator	The red light stays on during charging and turns off when the peaker is fully charged.	
9	DC charging port	DC Charging Port – To charge the speaker	
10	USB slot	USB input (Flash Drive)	
11	Aux-in jack	To play music through auxiliary cable.	
12	Micro SD (TF) slot	Micro SD (TF) card input	

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Charging the speaker

For best results, fully charge the speaker before its first use.

- 1. Connect the USB charging cord (included) to the DC 5V charging port of the speaker and insert the other end into a port on your computer or similar power source.
- 2. Red LED glows indicating that the battery is being charged. Once it is fully charged, the Red LED will turn off. It will take around 2-3 hours to fully charge the battery.

Turn On/Off the Speaker with an LED Lantern

Press and hold the "Power" button for 1-2 seconds until you hear the indication tone. Blue LED indicator light will blink, your speaker is now ON and is entering "pairing" mode. Press and hold the "Power" button for 1-2 seconds to turn off the speaker.

Turn the speaker to Bluetooth pairing mode -

- 1. Press and hold the "Power" button for 1-2 seconds until you hear the indication tone.
- 2. The blue LED indicator light will blink, your speaker is now ON and is entering "pairing" mode.

(Note: Speaker automatically pairs with the previously paired devices)

Pairing your device with Bluetooth Speaker -

Your Bluetooth Speaker can wirelessly stream audio from any Bluetooth-enabled device within a distance of 27-33 Feet. Simply follow the below steps.

- 1. Press and hold the "Power" button for 1-2 seconds until you hear the indication tone.
- 2. The blue LED indicator light will blink, your speaker is now ON and is entering "pairing" mode.
- 3. Turn on the Bluetooth on your Mobile Phone Tablet or Computer.
- 4. It will search for various devices.
- 5. The pairing name of our Bluetooth Speaker is "Sound Touch", pair it with this device.
- 6. You might be prompted with a "Pair with Sound Touch?" message on your source device, with "Cancel" and "OK" options. Please click "OK".
- 7. If required, enter the password '0000' to confirm the finalized pairing.
- 8. Once paired successfully, you will hear an indication tone and the blue LED indicator light will stay on.
- 9. If you fail to pair it within the time frame or you want to pair it with a new device please the steps outlined above.
- 10. Select your favorite song on your Bluetooth device and the music should then stream through the Bluetooth speaker.

Talking using the Bluetooth Speaker

Please ensure that your mobile phone is paired with the Bluetooth Speaker to use the below functions.

Function	Operation	Button
Answer Incoming Call	Incoming Call	Short press the Phone button to answer an incoming call.
End Call	Incoming Call	After your phone conversation, short-press the Phone button
Volume Increase	During a call	A long press on the + button will increase the volume
Volume Decrease	During a call	A long press on the – button will decrease the volume
Redial last number	Standby mode and connected to a device	Short press the Phone button twice

Listening to Music Wirelessly

Please ensure that your device (iPhone, Tablet o, or Other Smart Phone) is paired with the Bluetooth Speaker to stream music wirelessly. Once it is paired, play music from your device.

(Note: An indication tone will alert you when the volume is adjusted to the maximum level.) Listening to Music using Ua SB / Micro SD (TF) Card Slot –

- · Turn ON the device.
- Insert the USB flash drive into the USB slot or a Micro SD (TF) card into the Micro SD.
- (TF) card slot accordingly, music would play automatically.
- To Skip Track Forward Short press the + button.
- To Skip Track Backwards Short press the button.
- To Pause the Track Short press the ▶ button.
- To Play the Track Short press the ▶ button.
- Long press + to increase the volume or to decrease the volume.

(Note: When you insert a USB flash drive into the USB slot or a Micro SD (TF) card into the

• Micro SD (TF) card slot of the speaker accordingly, the Bluetooth of the speaker will turn off, automatically.)

Play music using "Aux-In" Jack

- 1. Turn ON the device.
- 2. Insert the 3.5 mm Aux-in cable (included) in the Aux-in jack of the speaker. And, the other end of the cable, to the audio device (such as a computer/tablet, etc.).
- 3. The Blue LED indicator light will flash.
- 4. Select your favorite song at the source device.

(Note: When you insert a 3.5 mm Aux-in cable into the Aux-in jack of the speaker, the Bluetooth or stream music from the USB / Micro SD (TF) card of the speaker will turn off, automatically. Functions except for Volume Increase or Volume Decrease can be only

controlled through source devices while playing music in Auxiliary mode. An indication tone will alert you when the volume is adjusted to the maximum level.)

Tips!!

1. Short press the Mode button each time to switch different functions of the speaker. The modes appear in the

- following sequence Bluetooth / USB-Micro SD (TF) / AUX-In.
- 2. When the unit is not in use, turn Off the device to save the battery power.

Warm White LED light Mode (LEDs are not replaceable)

- 1. Turn ON the device, the Warm White LED light is in low light mode.
- 2. Short press the LED light button each time or tap the top of the speaker once to change the brightness. The light level of brightnesincludeses low -> medium -> high -> Off.

Color Changing LED light Mode (LEDs are not replaceable)

- 1. Turn ON the device.
- 2. Tap and hold the top of the speaker for about 2 seconds to switch the LED light from Warm White LED light mode to Color Changing LED light mode.
- 3. When in Color Changing LED Light mode, short press the LED light button each time or tap the top of the speaker once to change the LED Light color. The light modes include: Blue -> Green -> Red -> Cyan -> Purple -> Turquoise -> Color Changing -> Dynamic -> Off. Dynamic mode moves through the LED light colorswhileh playing music beats.
- 4. While it is on any color light mode, tap and hold the top of the speaker for about 2 seconds to change back to Warm White LED light mode.

Do's and Don'ts

- Do not play music at excessive levels. Damage to hearing and/or equipment may result.
- Do not use outdoors in excessive rain or extreme weather conditions.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Low sound level	Source (Tablet, Mobile Phone, Laptop, etc.) volume is too low. Battery dead	Adjust source volume. Charge Battery.
Sound distorted	Battery nearly dead	Charge Battery.
	Source (Tablet, Mobile Phone, Laptop.) turne d off.	Turn the source on.
No sound at all.	The speaker turned off. Volume turned down the source. The media paused on the source.	Turn the speaker on. Adjust volume source. Play media fro m source.

Care and Maintenance

Clean the unit with a soft, damp cloth. Never use chemicals or hard abrasives. Store in cool dry conditions away from wet or dawetings.
