CREATE YOUR ACCOUNT

Get an all-access pass to your account by creating your username. Learn about your services and manage your account 24/7. You can also watch TV online, check your email, manage your bill and more, from any device, everywhere you go! Visit Spectrum.net/CreateAccount from any computer connected to your home network to create your username.

MANAGING YOUR ACCOUNT

Download the My Spectrum App to manage your account on-the-go. You can also manage your account at Spectrum.net.

- View your bill, make a payment, enroll in Auto Pay, edit your existing Auto Pay, enroll in paperless billing and more.
- Troubleshoot your services or connection issues, review your subscription, view and manage the equipment associated with your account and manage your Voice features.
- Change your communication preferences, view and update your contact information and create additional accounts for other members of your household.

UNDERSTANDING YOUR BILL

Your first statement will include the first month of billing for services, equipment lease fees, installation charges, taxes and any prepayment collected. Statements after that should reflect charges for the current billing month or billing cycle.

- 4. Review Payment Info and select Make Payment to finalize. Be sure to review all your payment details before finalizing your payment online.

PROGRAMMING YOUR REMOTE

Your Spectrum Remote can be programmed to control your TV and other devices. For a full list of our remotes and instructions, visit **Spectrum.net/Remotes**



- 1. Make sure your TV is powered on.
- 2. Simultaneously press and hold MENU and OK keys on remote until the INPUT key blinks twice.
- 3. Press and release the TV POWER key once.
- 4. Find your TV's brand in the chart. Press and hold down the digit key that corresponds to your TV's brand.

5. The TV will turn off to confirm that you've successfully programmed your device.

See all your TV choices with the most up-to-date listing of the stations and networks in your area. You can see channels by package (Select, Silver or Gold) or by category (Lifestyle, Movies, Sports). View channels at Spectrum.net/Channels Available in the My Spectrum App

DVR

Take complete control of your TV experience. Pause live broadcasts and use customized recording options so you can watch your favorite shows on your terms. To access your DVR, press the DVR button or LIST button on your remote.

PARENTAL CONTROLS

SPECTRUM TV APP

The Spectrum TV App gives you the ability to watch your favorite content virtually anywhere on multiple devices. With the Spectrum TV App, enjoy hundreds of live TV channels and thousands of On Demand TV shows and movies inside or outside your home. The Spectrum TV App can be watched in or out of your home depending on the device used, and can be downloaded to your mobile device from your app store or to your Xbox One or Samsung Smart TV through the device console.

Note: Channel availability varies by area. Content for Spectrum TV App on Mobile may differ from that of Spectrum TV subscription package due to programming rights in some markets. Spectrum TV App requires Spectrum TV and a connection to the Internet. Spectrum TV is supported on the following devices: iPad or iPhone with iOS 9 or later, Android tablet or phone with 4.2 or later, Kindle Fire HD/HDX, Xbox One, Samsung Smart TV (2012 or later models), and laptops/computers with Internet Explorer 10 or later, Firefox 39 or later, Chrome 41 or later, Safari 5 or later and Opera 28 or later. REFRESHING YOUR SPECTRUM RECEIVER

If your Spectrum Receiver isn't working properly, a refresh can help resolve many issues without affecting your recordings or service. If you are experiencing any of the below issues, refreshing your receiver may fix your issues:

- · Missing channels
- Problems with the interactive guide
- · No picture
- Poor picture quality To refresh your receiver:
- 1. On your PC, go to Spectrum.net and sign in.
- 2. Hover over My Account and Select TV.
- Click Refresh in the Equipment screen.

FIXING PICTURE QUALITY ISSUES

There are a couple of easy things you can do to troubleshoot your video picture.

- Check all your cables from your TV to your Spectrum Receiver, and from the Coaxial cable from the wall to your Spectrum Receiver. Make sure they are tight!
- Try refreshing your receiver on Spectrum.net under Manage Account.
- If cables are tight, unplug your receiver for 15 seconds and then plug it back in and power on. It may take
 several minutes for the receiver to reboot. Once it's rebooted, check the video picture.

IN-HOME WIFI

WHERE TO PLACE YOUR ROUTER FOR THE BEST CONNECTION:

Place your Modem-Router combo or WiFi Router in a central and open location. We recommend a wired Internet connection for high bandwidth usage devices such as Smart TVs, TV streaming devices and gaming consoles—this helps avoid interference and increases available WiFi bandwidth for other devices.

DO place:

- · in a central location
- on a raised surface
- in an open space

DON'T place:

- · in a media center or closet
- · near wireless or radio signals like cordless phones
- · behind a TV

WIFI NETWORK NAME AND PASSWORD

You can manage your In-Home WiFi network at Spectrum.net. From here, you can view your customized settings, such as WiFi Network Name (SSID) and WiFi Password.

TROUBLESHOOTING YOUR INTERNET SERVICE

If you are experiencing slow speeds or if your WiFi connection is intermittent, check the following:

- Distance from the Modem-Router or WiFi Router: The farther away from the WiFi Router you are, the weaker
 your signal will be. Try moving closer to your WiFi Router to see if the connection improves. WiFi signal
 strength may deteriorate over longer distances and as it passes through the construction materials of your
 home.
- Modem-Router or WiFi Router Location and Obstacles: Your WiFi Router should be placed in a central location for best coverage. Learn more at <u>Spectrum.net/WiFiTrouble</u>

If you still continue to experience slow speeds, try resetting your Internet modem by following these steps:

- 1. Unplug the power cord from the back of the modem.
- 2. Wait 30 seconds, then reconnect power to the modem.
- 3. Wait two minutes to allow the modem to connect. The modem connection lights will be solid.
- Confirm you are connected to the Internet by surfing to two or more web pages.

To activate and set up your voicemail from your home phone, dial *99. Follow the voice prompts to create a PIN

FROM YOUR COMPUTER OR MOBILE DEVICE:

- Dial your 10-digit home phone number
- Press * when you hear the greeting
- Enter your PIN, followed by the # sign

TROUBLESHOOTING YOUR VOICE SERVICE

If you are experiencing trouble with your phone services, such as no dial tone, you should reset your Voice modem by unplugging the power cord for 30 seconds and reconnecting. You can also reset your Voice modem by following these simple steps:

- 1. Unplug the power cord from the back of the modem and remove any batteries.
- 2. Wait 30 seconds, then reinsert any batteries and reconnect power to the modem.
- 3. Wait two minutes to allow the modem to connect. The modem connection lights will be solid.
- Attempt to make a phone call.

ENHANCED 911 (E911)

To reach fi re, police or ambulance services, just dial 911. To help you remember to dial 911 IMMEDIATELY in case of any emergency, we've provided stickers to place on or near your phone. Enhanced 911 (E911) automatically provides the emergency service operator with your phone number and location. To ensure that 911 calls are properly routed:

- Don't move the equipment installed in your home to another location.
- If you use our service from an address that's different from the one you initially provided, the E911 service won't work properly.
- When you plan to move and need to change your service address, please call Customer Care so that we can properly move your service.

BATTERY BACKUP

Spectrum Voice uses the electrical power in your home, so if there's a power outage all calling will be interrupted —including 911 service. Ask us about purchasing and installing a battery backup, which provides hours of standby Voice service in the event of a power outage—just call (855) 757-7328. Learn more at Spectrum.net/Battery

FAQS

Is the Spectrum TV app free?

The Spectrum TV app is an app for set-top streaming boxes and mobile devices that delivers Spectrum TV over Spectrum internet. **The app is free**, but it's tied to Spectrum internet service and your specific Spectrum cable TV plan.

How much is Spectrum TV app a month?

Spectrum TV Choice is a live TV streaming service available only to Spectrum internet customers in certain Spectrum areas for **\$44.99 per month**.

Is Spectrum TV free on Roku?

There's no extra charge if you're a Spectrum TV and internet customer. The Roku app is just a portal into content you're already paying for. Of course, for everyone else, the cost is switching internet and/or TV providers.

Do you need cable for Spectrum TV app?

The Spectrum TV App is a mobile application that allows you to watch live TV and On Demand content at **no** additional charge from your mobile device. You can also tune to your DVR, schedule recordings, browse the channel guide, search for content, learn about your favorite shows and more!

How many channels do you get with Spectrum streaming?

Well, Spectrum TV Choice is a live TV streaming service available only to Spectrum internet customers in certain Spectrum areas. It offers a trimmed-down channel lineup (15 cable channels of your choice plus local channels) and a lower monthly price (\$29.99 per month) than Spectrum's traditional cable TV plan.

What is the cheapest Spectrum TV package?

Spectrum TV Select is the cheapest Spectrum TV plan. Spectrum TV Select costs \$49.99 per month and includes 125+ channels.

How much does the Spectrum app on Roku cost?

Spectrum TV Essentials is a live TV streaming service that includes live entertainment, lifestyle, and news channels for only **\$15/month**.

Why is Roku not supporting Spectrum?

The agreement resolves **an ongoing carriage dispute** that resulted in Roku pulling the Spectrum TV app from its store in December. The companies issued a joint statement on Tuesday that both had come to "a mutually beneficial agreement to renew distribution of the Spectrum TV App."

Does firestick have Spectrum TV?

Spectrum TV is available on Kindle Fire and Fire HDX second generation and above. Stream live TV anywhere you have a connection. Enjoy streaming thousands of On Demand shows and movies.

What is the difference between Spectrum TV stream and Spectrum TV choice?

DirecTV Stream's lineup includes 70 channels whereas Spectrum TV Choice has only 15 channels. Getting a subscription to DirecTV Stream will give you access to 55 more channels than Spectrum TV Choice.

What are the 23 channels Spectrum is dropping?

The Channel name includes MTV, Nickelodeon, Comedy Central, VH1, MTV Live, BET, CMT, Spike, Nick Jr., Nick Music, TV Land, LOGO TV, MTV2, TeenNick, BET Her, CMT Music, BET Jams, MTV Classic Tr3s, BET Soul, MTVU, and Nick 2,Nicktoons.

Why is my Spectrum bill so high?

Spectrum is raising its cable and internet/phone bundle rates in April 2022. Cable companies blame much of the increase on broadcasters and networks who are charging them more, with the costs passed on to consumers.

Does spectrum TV have local channels?

Basic channels on Spectrum include your local networks — **ABC, CBS, FOX and NBC** — as well as other public access or government channels, including C-SPAN, the CW, HSN, MeTV, PBC and QVC.

Can Roku replace Spectrum cable box?

Streaming devices like the Roku, Fire TV, and Apple TV have the Spectrum TV app in their app stores and have the same functionality that the app on the phone offers. You'll need to be signed for Spectrum TV and internet to stream on other devices, so make sure your internet is from Spectrum before proceeding.1

Is Spectrum streaming better than cable?

Yes, streaming services are better than cable, as long as your internet speeds are fast enough for streaming. You can still watch all your favorite live channels while paying less than most traditional cable TV plans cost, especially once you factor in hidden cable TV fees.

Which TV streaming service is best?

But despite all that, **Hulu Plus Live TV** is still second banana to our top live TV streaming premium pick, YouTube TV. While its channel selection still isn't as robust as YouTube TV and FuboTV, it's Hulu's significant catalog of ondemand content which helps set it apart

Does Spectrum have Amazon Prime?

Access to more than 400 On Demand movie titles from Lionsgate, Sony, Disney, IFC, Paramount, Universal and Warner Brothers with more titles coming in the future. Multiple viewing options – **You can use Spectrum TV or a streaming service of your choice such as Hulu, Netflix or Amazon Prime**.

Why does Spectrum have 2 of the same channel?

Spectrum has duplicate channels **due to the quality of the channels**. Spectrum has channels in standard definition, and the duplicate version is high definition. This allows people with a basic or enhanced package to watch the same beloved channels no matter their package level.
