


Thanks for choosing to sell with Square Terminal





What's in the box



Charging your Terminal


Terminal has a rechargeable battery so it doesn't always need to be plugged into a power outlet. When the battery is running low, simply charge it up.

Loading receipt paper


Make sure you position and orient the roll exactly as shown in step 2. When tearing off a receipt, tear it down toward the screen.
