- 2. Navigate to the Windows folder and run Setup.exe as Administrator.
- 3. Follow on-screen instructions to install the device drivers and software.

For macOS:

- 1. Double-click the Software Pack.zip file.
- 2. Double-click the Install.dmg file.
- 3. Double-click USB Crash Cart Adapter.

Hardware Installation:

- 1. Once the software is installed on the notebook computer, plug the USB Crash Cart Adapter into the server.
- 2. Connect the DE-15 VGA cable and USB type A cable into the server.
- 3. For DVI-I (analog) computer systems, use a DVI to VGA adapter (StarTech.com ID: DVIVGAMF).

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Can the USB Crash Cart Adapter be connected or disconnected while the server is running?

A: Yes, the USB Crash Cart Adapter can be connected or disconnected at any time without affecting the server.

Q: Is it necessary to start or shut down the software before unplugging the USB Crash Cart Adapter?

A: No, you do not need to start or shut down the software before unplugging the USB Crash Cart Adapter.

Installation

Windows

Drivers and software must be installed on the computer before you connect the USB Crash Adapter. To install the software, complete the following:.

- Download the latest drivers from the StarTech.com website, (https://www.startech.com/NOTECONS01).
 Note: Windows typically saves the files to the Downloads folder that is associated with your user account (for example, C:\Users \your name \Downloads)
- 2. When the download is complete, right-click the zip folder that you downloaded, click Extract All, and follow the on-screen instructions.
- 3. In the list of extracted files, navigate to the Windows folder, right- click the Setup.exe file and click Run as Administrator.

Note: If the Run as Administrator option is not available, you might be attempting to run the installer from within the zipped file. Extract the files using the instructions in step 2

4. Follow the on-screen prompts to install the device drivers and software.

macOS

Drivers and software must be installed on the computer before you connect the USB Crash Adapter. To install the software, complete the following:

- 1. Download the latest drivers from the StarTech.com website,(https://www.startech.com/NOTECONS01).
 - **Note:** Mac OS X will typically save the files to the Downloads folder that is associated with your user account (for example,hard_drive_name\Users \your_namel Downloads).
- 2. Double-click the Software Pack.zip file.
- 3. Double-click the Install.dmg file.
- 4. Double-click USB Crash Cart Adapter.
- 5. The program is now located on the desktop and is ready to run.

Hardware Installation

Once the drivers and software for the USB Crash Cart Adapter are installed on the notebook computer, it can be plugged into the server.

Connect the attached DE-15 VGA cable and the USB type A cable into the desired server. For DVI-I (analog) computer systems, please use a DVI to VGA adapter (StarTech.com ID: DVIVGAMF).
