# PAIRING THE WIRELESS SHUTTER TO YOUR PHONE

- 1. Pull to remove the clear plastic tab from the wireless remote to activate the internal battery.
- 2. Hold down and press the remote button to power on and the LED indicator will flash blue.
- 3. Search and pair with BT name "Selfie Stick" on your cellphone. The LED indicator will stop flashing after it is successfully connected.
  - Use the remote control to take pictures from your phone when you are using the tripod.
- 4. The remote control will automatically shut down in 5 minutes if not paired to conserve battery.
- 5. The remote control will go into sleep mode in 10 minutes if not being used.
- 6. Hold down and press the remote button to power off and the LED indicator will flash 3 times.

## USING THE BUILT-IN RECHARGEABLE LIGHT

- 1. Connect the included Micro USB cable for 1 hour to charge the internal battery on the light.
- 2. To turn the light ON or OFF hold down the power button on the side of the light for approx 3 seconds.
