

Main Menu



1. All Menus

- Radio: Converts to the last played radio mode.
- SiriusXM: Listen to the channel

- Audio Settings: Sound settings
- Android Auto: Run the Android Auto function.
- Apple CarPlay: Runs the Apple CarPlay function.
- **Settings**: Moves to the settings menu.

2. All Menus

- BT Phone: Answer and make a call
- Bluetooth: Connect the mobile phone to play mobile audio
- **USB**: Converts to the last played USB mode.
- Camera: Show the camera picture
- Display Off: The device enters the screen off state

Radio




- FM Click to switch FM mode.
- AM Click to switch AM mode.
- Distant/Loc : Search the range of channels
- Auto: Channel search mode
- Press Manual input channel

- SXM Click to switch FM
- Press Manual input channel
- Press SiriusXM Settings


Audio Settings



• Settings You can adjust the sound position by clicking the up/down/ left / right arrow.



• Equalizer You: You can set the equalizer by yourself and save it




• Crossover You can adjust Slope Frequency Level of these parameters




• Factory EQ You can choose a Factory EQ model.

Connect the wireless carplay


- 1. press [settings-device-device list] to the wireless CarPlay connection interface
- 2. Click [add a device] to search for available wireless CarPlay devices. Press the cancel button to stop the search.
- 3. Click the button to connect to the paired device, and click the button to delete the paired device.

Settings

• Press the [Settings] icon on the All Menus interface to enter the setup menu interface.




- Press[Clock]: You can set the device time
- Press[Microphone]: You can set the Microphone
- Press[System Beep Volume]: You can set the beep switch
- Press[Language]: You can set the Language



- Press[Auto Brightness]: You can set auto brightness
- Press[Display Brightness]: You can set the brightness of the screen
- Press[Face Button Color]: You can set the color of the panel light

- Press[Face Button Brightness]: You can set the color of the light on the engine panel
- Press[Background]: You can set the background of the machine

• Click on the display keyboard to make a call




Favourites

• Show cell phone records




Contacts

Settings

• Click to display the device connected to the machine



Bluetooth

When Bluetooth is connected, click to play BT music.



- Press[Previous button]: You can switch to the previous one
- Press the [Next button]: You can switch to the next song

USB

When the USB disk is inserted, the USB music icon is highlighted. Click USBmusic to enter the USB music interface.



Pause

- You can pause the playing file
- Press [II] on the screen.

Play

Press [▶] on the screen to play it again.

Previous button

- When it is pressed for a short time.
- Press the previous button to switch to the last video (playing progress does not exceed 5 seconds).
- Press the previous button, the currently playing video will restart (Play progress exceeds 5 seconds).
- When it is pressed and held Rewind the currently playing video

Next button

• When it is pressed for a short time. Press a button to cut to the next video When it is pressed and held. Fast forward the currently playing video

Repeat

• Switch the repeat mode of the song: Repeat All, Repeat Folder, and Repeat Track.

File Button


You can choose to play music, video, or pictures

• You can search for the USB file you are looking for.
