## Connect your device

- Connect your AC cable to a grounded outlet and your RJ45 cable
  STORM AUDIO-ISP-ISR-Immersive-Sound-Receiver-fig- (10)
- 2. LAN cable to your local router. Connect your inputs and outputs to the processor.
- 3. Power up your unit, and the display will show the StormAudio icon for a few seconds.
