


Figure 1-1. Serial Tag Layout

## **Interactive Control Panel**

For initial start up, touch and hold 'power' on the control panel for 2 seconds. Temperature can be adjusted in one-degree increments on the home screen. Combination units have separate temper-ature controls for refrigerator and freezer. Temperatures are preset at 38°F (3°C) and 0°F (-18°C). To change temperature, touch the temperature being adjusted, then press '+' or '-' until desired temperature is displayed. Refer to the illustra-tion below.

Once temperature has been adjusted, additional features can be activated or deactivated from the options screen. Touch to view the options screen. Refer to the illustration below.

- Touch to activate or deactivate door/drawer alarm.
- Touch to activate or deactivate water dispenser.
- Touch to activate or deactivate air purification system.




Figure 1-2. Model ICBIC-18F




Figure 1-4. Model ICBIC-24FI




Figure 1-5. Model ICBIC-30RID




Figure 1-6. Model ICBIC-30FI




Figure 1-8. Model ICBIT-30RID




Figure 1-9. Model ICBIT-30CIID
