



Product Usage Instructions

- 1. Ensure that the device is placed on a flat and stable surface.
- 2. Insert the batteries into the remote control according to the polarity markings.
- 3. Press the power button on the device or the remote control to turn it on.
- 4. Use the arrow buttons on the remote control to navigate through the menu options.
- 5. Press the OK button to select the desired option.
- 6. Adjust the settings such as brightness, contrast, and volume according to your preference.

Note: This device complies with FCC Part 15 regulations. It should not cause any interference, and should accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.



FCC Statement for Remote Control
