Outdoor Tech Buckshot 2.0 Rugged Bluetooth Speaker



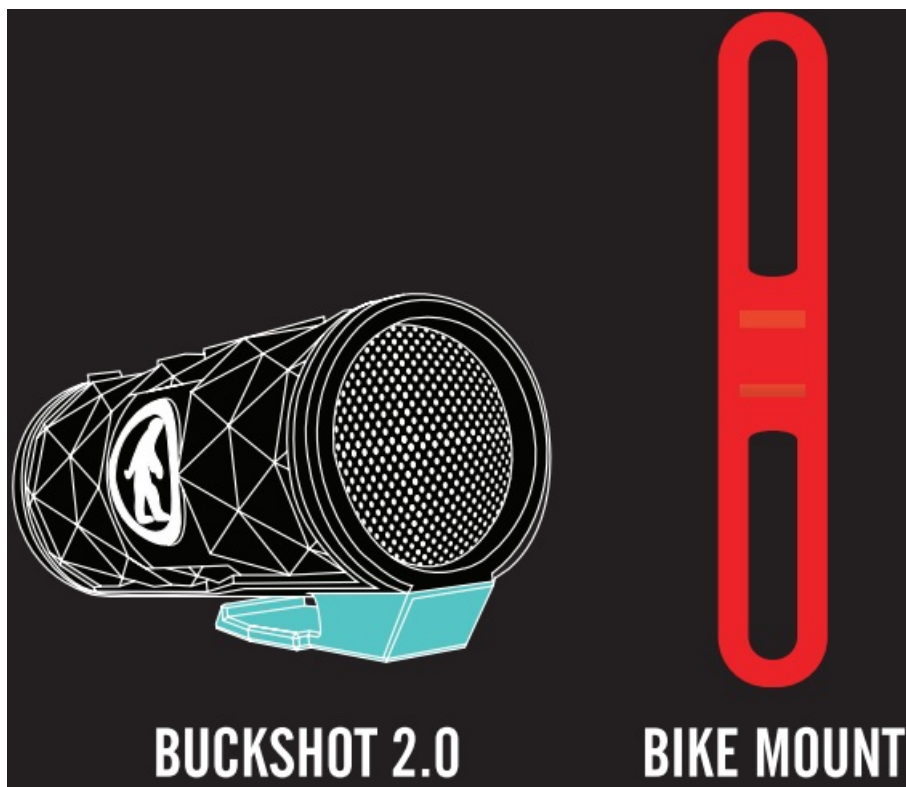
Good call on picking up the Outdoor Tech.

This manual exists to help make sure you can use 'em to the fullest potential. So sit back, put your feet up, and flip through this to get to know your Buckshot 2.0.

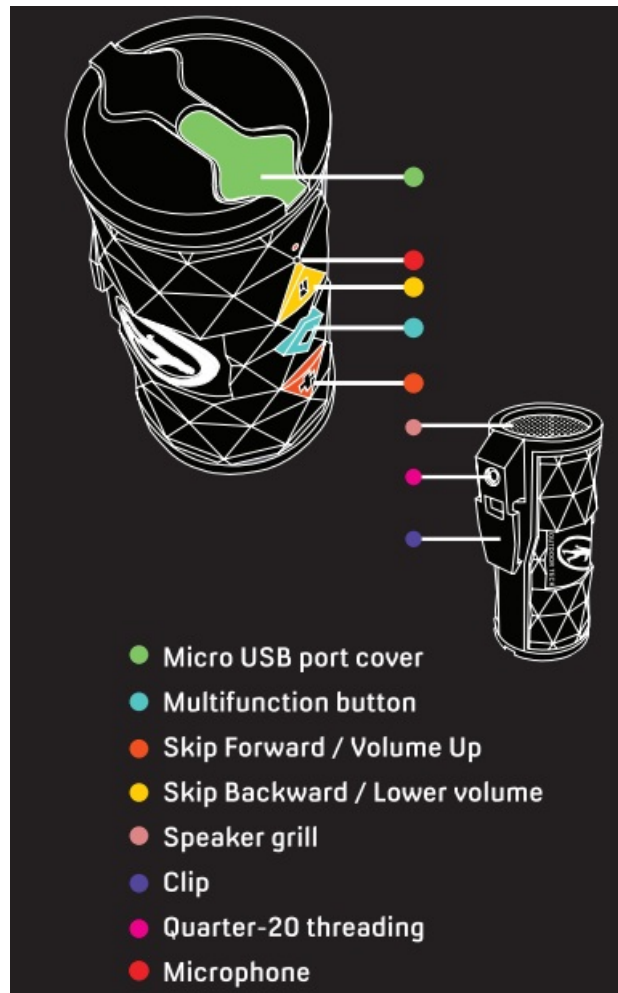

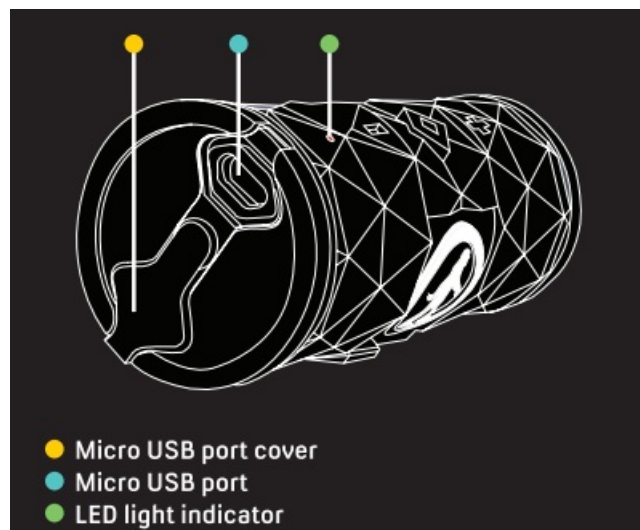


Micro USB Cord and instructional manual are also included in the packaging.

ANATOMY



POWER UP



TO CHARGE

1. Connect the included Micro USB cord to a power source and the charging port on the Buckshot 2.0. When charging, the red LED light will stay activated. ***Full charge time is about 4-5 hours.
2. When the Buckshot 2.0's is fully charged, the RED light will turn off.

The displayed battery meter is supported for Apple products.

The Buckshot 2.0's Bluetooth and music functions can still operate while charging.

PAIRING MOOD

Power On / Off

ON: Hold the MFB for 2-3 seconds or until the LED light flashes blue and the voice prompt states "Power on"

OFF: Hold the MFB for 3-4 seconds or until the LED light turns red and the voice prompt states "Power off"


Enter Pairing Mode

When powered on, it will enter into pairing mode automatically. Hold the MFB for 2-3 seconds or until you see the LED light flash red/blue and the voice prompts states "Power on, Pairing." The LED lights will then flash red and blue alternately.

Pairing Buckshot 2.0 to Device

Open the Bluetooth settings on your device. If you have put your Buckshot 2.0 into pairing mode, it should be listed as "ODT Buckshot 2.0" as an available device to pair. Connect with the Buckshot 2.0. The voice prompt will state "Connected" if the Buckshot 2.0 and your device are connected. The blue LED light will flash for as long as the device is connected and on.

MUSIC FUNCTION




Music/Device Controls

Skip backward Volume down MFB Skip forward Volume up


*The Volume up button is closest to the speaker end of the Buckshot Pro2.0.

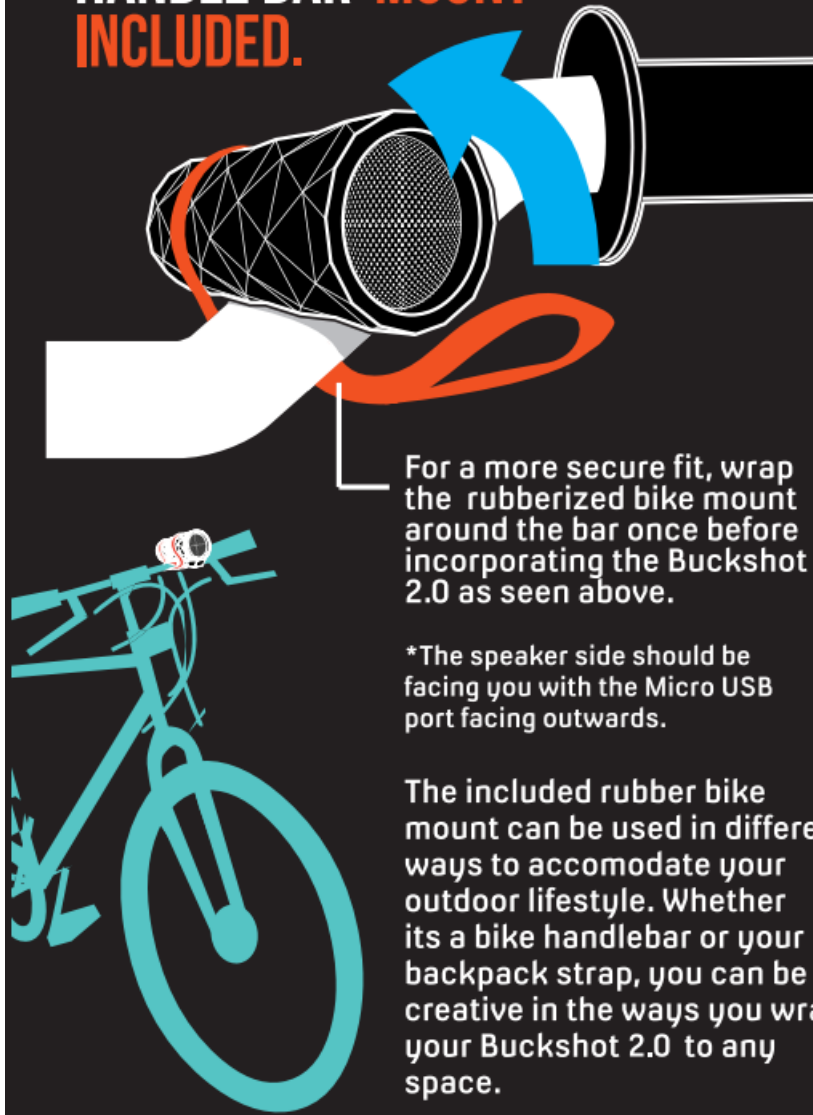

MOUNTING OPTIONS

HANDLE BAR MOUNT INCLUDED.



For a more secure fit, wrap the rubberized bike mount around the bar once before incorporating the Buckshot 2.0 as seen above.

*The speaker side should be facing you with the Micro USB port facing outwards.

The included rubber bike mount can be used in different ways to accommodate your outdoor lifestyle. Whether its a bike handlebar or your backpack strap, you can be creative in the ways you wrap your Buckshot 2.0 to any space.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- Do not access the input/output simultaneously.
It may affect the product's performance and not charge properly.
- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the surface.
Do not use intensive chemical products or detergents to clean the product.
- Charge the product at least once every three months, to prevent the batteries from drying out.
- It is normal for the battery to heat up during its charge. The temperature should be below 45° & does not affect the Buckshot 2.0s performance.
- For best performance, fully charge the Buckshot 2.0 before charging other devices.
- All products have passed the strict quality inspection, Do not use the battery/device if it gives off an odor, generates heat, becomes deformed, abrasion, damaged or appears abnormal in any way

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTION

How does a Bluetooth speaker for the outside operate?

This is a more recent product category in which a conventional pair of waterproof outdoor speakers has amplifiers and a Bluetooth receiver integrated in. These work just like a single Bluetooth speaker: Start streaming music by simply pairing your phone or tablet with the infrastructure.

How does a Bluetooth outdoor speaker operate?

A Bluetooth receiver and amplifier are integrated into a conventional pair of waterproof outdoor speakers in this more recent product category. These function identically as a single Bluetooth speaker: To begin streaming music, just connect your phone or tablet to the system.

How do I connect my Bluetooth Bumpbox?

Hold your phone or another Bluetooth-enabled device within three feet of your speaker, press and hold the Play/Pause button for three seconds, and the system will enter pairing mode. The indicator light should start blinking blue and red at this point.

What advantages can Bluetooth speakers offer?

Full-range audio can be brought into any room of your house with Bluetooth speakers, and they don't cost much money or take up much room. The most adaptable speaker you can own is a Bluetooth speaker, hands down. You have a quick and efficient way to get music whenever and wherever you need it.

The source of electricity for Bluetooth speakers

Yes, the majority of wireless speakers plug into standard power outlets or power strips using AC adaptors.

How do tough speakers function?

To connect, turn on Bluetooth on your device, search for Bluetooth devices, and then choose “onn. Rugged LG GRY.” The speaker can be connected to another audio source with a 3.5mm connection (not included). To get the desired volume, press Play on the gadget and then adjust the volume there.

How is a tough speaker recharged?

ASSESSING PRODUCT Please utilise the USB port on the speaker’s side to charge any device. Any smart phone or tablet that requires an output of up to 1 a can be charged using the tough speaker. A 4000 mah rechargeable Li-Ion battery powers the speaker. Any smart phone device may often be fully charged by a speaker one time.

Why can’t Bluetooth locate devices?

The device you’re trying to pair with Bluetooth frequently doesn’t appear in the list when your phone searches for Bluetooth devices. The device’s own Bluetooth is typically either off or not in pairing mode when this happens. To find out how to activate pairing mode and make it discoverable, consult the user handbook.

Can I connect a Bluetooth speaker to my phone?

Make sure Bluetooth is turned on by going to Settings -> Bluetooth to accomplish this. Then, locate and choose the Bluetooth speaker you wish to connect to. You should then be able to stream audio from your Android mobile to the Bluetooth speaker after it has connected to it.

How can a non-charging Bluetooth speaker be fixed?

Installing software updates, replacing the battery, purchasing a new cable, repairing a cracked solder joint, replacing the charging port, and replacing the charging circuit are all necessary fixes for a Bluetooth speaker that won’t charge.

Without Bluetooth, how can I connect my phone to a speaker?

You can use an aux cable to connect the device if it supports aux. You will need to purchase a Bluetooth adapter and attach it straight to this port if your other devices use USB ports. Connect it to the speaker you already have.

Can Bluetooth speakers be used without internet?

Instead of an internet connection, short-range radio waves are how Bluetooth operates.

What are the benefits and drawbacks of Bluetooth?

It can pass through barriers and uses little electricity. Its range is superior to that of infrared communication. Since the Bluetooth SIG is in charge of managing it, large companies’ products are available, and there is no problem with interoperability between various Bluetooth vendor products.
