The SYNCWIRE SW-XC966 Bluetooth FM Transmitter is a unique gadget that makes your car trips easier, more fun, and more efficient. This small device, which costs \$18.19, is made to connect your phone or tablet to your car's music system without any problems. The SW-XC966 was released in 2021 by the well-known tech accessory brand SYNCWIRE. It has Bluetooth 5.4 technology for faster and more stable connections, rainbow lighting that can be changed to create a lively atmosphere, and two microphones with noise cancellation for clear hands-free talks. At 3.43 x 2.36 x 1.73 inches and 2.46 ounces, it's small enough to fit into the cigarette lighter socket in your car. The device also has better HiFi deep bass for playing high-quality music and can charge up to 54W safely and quickly. The SW-XC966 makes your car more stylish and useful, whether you're driving or going on a road trip.

- Two Microphones: It has two high-tech microphones and CVC 8.0 noise reduction so you can make clear calls without using your hands in loud places.
- Customizable Rainbow Lighting: It has an attractive rainbow LED light that can be turned off by pressing the "b" button for a long time. This makes for a relaxing driving environment.



- **HiFi Deep Bass Sound**: With the touch of a button, you can get high-fidelity sound with increased bass that surrounds you.
- Ports for Fast Charging: It has a 36W PD USB-C port and an 18W QC3.0 USB-A port so that two devices can be charged quickly and safely at the same time.



- Wide Compatibility: It works perfectly with smartphones, tablets, and MP3 players that have Bluetooth and sends sound via FM.
- **LED Screen:** An easy-to-read LED screen shows the FM frequency, the status of the connection, and the charging process.
- Hands-Free Calling: Can answer, redial, and reject calls using buttons, so you can focus on driving.
- Memory Function: It automatically links to the last device it was paired with and picks up where it left off with settings like FM frequency.
- Noise Suppression Technology: Lowers noise from the road and the wind so you can hear music and calls clearly.
- Plug-and-Play Setup: Just plug it into the cigarette lighter switch in your car, and it's ready to use in seconds.
- Small and Lightweight Design: It has a sleek shape that makes it easy to carry and doesn't get in the way in the car.

SETUP GUIDE

- Plug in Power: Connect the transmitter to the cigarette lighter plug in your car.
- Power On: When you connect the device to your car, it turns on immediately.

- Choose an FM channel: For best results, tune the car radio to an FM channel that isn't being used.
- Set Transmitter Frequency: Use the "+" and "-" buttons to change the transmitter's frequency to match the chosen FM frequency.
- Pair with Device: Make sure your phone or other device is set to Bluetooth and choose "SW-XC966" from the list of devices.
- Check the Connection: Once pairing is complete, the emitter will let you know.
- Test Audio: To make sure the sound is clear, play music or make a call.
- Change the Lighting: To turn on or off the rainbow lighting, long-press the "b" button.
- Turn on Bass Boost: Press the "b" button to turn on improved HiFi bass for better sound quality.
- Plugging Things In: To charge things quickly, connect them to the PD 36W or QC3.0 18W ports.
- As a hands-free caller, you can use the transmitter's buttons to answer, hang up, or redial the call.
- Automatically rejoin: Make sure Bluetooth is turned on so that it can automatically rejoin to the last device it was paired with.
- Switch FM Channels: If interference shows up, change the frequency to get a better link.
- Volume Control: For best results, change the volume right from the connected device or car radio.
- Reset Transmitter: If you're having trouble, unplug and plug in the transmitter again, and then pair your device again.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- **Keep Dry:** Keep it away from water or wetness to keep the internal parts from getting damaged.
- Clean it often: Use a soft, dry cloth to gently wipe the surface and LED screen to keep them dust-free.
- To keep the transmitter from getting too hot, don't leave it in direct sunlight or very hot temperatures for long amounts of time.
- Check Charging Ports: Make sure to check the USB ports often for dust or other things that could get in the way of charging.
- **Disconnect When Not in Use**: To save power and make the transmission last longer, unplug it when the car is not in use.
- Avoid Plugging in and Out Too Often: To keep the cigarette lighter link lasting longer, don't plug it in and out too often.
- Use cords That Work With Everything: To keep your devices from getting damaged or overloaded, only use certified cords with USB ports.
- Check FM Signal: For the best signal quality, make sure the chosen FM channel is not being used by anyone
 else.
- Keep it Safe: Keep the device in a cool, dry place when not in use to keep it from getting broken.
- Watch the device's temperature. If the emitter gets too hot, take it off and let it cool down before using it again.
- Update Device Firmware: To get the best performance, check the manufacturer's website for firmware
 patches.
- Avoid Harsh Chemicals: When you clean, don't use solvents or rough materials that could hurt the surface or devices.
- Secure Device: Make sure the transmitter is tightly seated in the cigarette lighter socket so that it doesn't get disconnected by accident.
- Check the Cables: Look for wear on the USB and charging cables and repair any that are broken right away.
- . Stay Away from Magnets: Don't put it near strong magnets or electric devices that might mess with its

TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Solution
No sound from the car speakers	Ensure the transmitter and car radio are set to the same FM frequency.
Static interference in music or calls	Switch to a clearer FM frequency and minimize nearby electronic interf erence.
Bluetooth device not pairing	Restart the transmitter and the Bluetooth device, then attempt to pair a gain.
Low audio quality	Increase the volume on your phone and the FM transmitter but avoid di stortion.
Unable to charge devices	Verify that the cigarette lighter socket is functional and the cable is sec ure.
Lights not functioning	Check if the transmitter is securely plugged in and powered.
Unstable connection	Reduce obstacles between the transmitter and paired device.
Calls not clear	Ensure the microphone is not obstructed and the car interior is quiet.
Rainbow lighting customization not wo rking	Refer to the manual for instructions on toggling the lighting modes.
Interference during hands-free calls	Use a quieter FM channel and reduce environmental noise.
FM transmitter won't power on	Confirm that the cigarette lighter socket is operational.
Buttons unresponsive	Reset the transmitter by unplugging and reinserting it into the socket.
Call dropping issues	Keep the phone within the 33-ft Bluetooth range for stable connectivity.
Music playback not working	Confirm compatibility of the USB or Bluetooth device and check for upd ates.
HiFi deep bass feature not noticeable	Ensure audio settings are optimized for enhanced bass playback.

How do I reset the SYNCWIRE SW-XC966 Bluetooth FM Transmitter?

To reset the SYNCWIRE SW-XC966, unplug it from the cigarette lighter socket, wait for a few seconds, and plug it back in. Pair it again if needed.


Why isn't the SYNCWIRE SW-XC966 Bluetooth FM Transmitter pairing with my phone?

Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your phone and that no other devices are connected to the SYNCWIRE SW-XC966. Delete the transmitter from your phone's Bluetooth list, restart both devices, and retry the pairing process.

Why is there static noise when using the SYNCWIRE SW-XC966 Bluetooth FM Transmitter?

Static noise may occur if the FM frequency selected on the SYNCWIRE SW-XC966 is too close to an active local station. Change the frequency to one with no local broadcasts for a clearer signal.
