

Controls

- 1. **USB** Connects to your computer for firmware updates and TonePrint editing.
- 2. **Delay** Adjusts the delay time.
- 3. MASH LED Indicates the intensity of MASH functionality.
- 4. **Level** Adjusts the level of the delay repeats.
- 5. Outputs
- 6. **Footswitch** Tap footswitch to turn effect on or off. Push down and hold to engage MASH and control the selected parameter.
- 7. **Power** Connect a 9 V / >100 mA power supply.
- 8. **Feedback** Determines the number of delay repeats.
- 9. **Subdivision** Selects between quarter note, dotted eighth note, or quarter plus dotted eighth note repetitions.
- 10. **Delay Type** Select delay type or TonePrint 1-3*.
- 11. Inputs

*NO AUDIO ON TONEPRINT 3?The default TonePrint 3 setting mutes the output. Use the MASH switch like a volume pedal to increase volume gradually.

FLASHBACK 2 DELAY AND LOOPER
