

## **Controls**



- 1. Key Selector Selects a major key for pitch correction. CH setting is either Chromatic (no Instrument) or Chords (Instrument connected).
- 2. Mic Input Level Control
- 3. Ground Lift Press the button inward if you experience buzz and hum.
- 4. Instrument Thru Send a copy of the instrument input signal to an amp or PA.
- 5. Effect Active LED
- 6. Effect On/Off Footswitch
- 7. USB Accepts the included mini-USB cable for firmware update.
- 8. Power Connect the included 12 V  $/ \ge 400$  mA power supply.
- 9. Input Level LED Green = signal, red = clip.
- 10. Mic Control Use the optional MP-75 mic (button in = on).
- 11. Guide Instrument Input
- 12. Gender Adjust your vocal biology between male and female.
- 13. Off/Hard Adjust the pitch correction attack from natural to robotic.
- 14. Out Connect to a mixer or powered speaker.
- 15. Mic Connect your microphone.
