Explanation of Warning Symbols and Notes



Risk of electric shock

This symbol indicates product parts energized with a dangerous voltage of sufficient magnitude to constitute a risk of electric shock.

This symbol is used to indicate additional information or important notes.

Danger!

- Do not open the device or continue to operate it if it becomes damaged.
- Do not use the product if the AC adapter, adapter cable is damaged.
- Do not attempt to service or repair the product yourself. Leave any and all service work to qualified experts.



- The device is intended exclusively for private and not for commercial use.
- · Only use this device as described in this user manual.
- Protect the product from dirt, moisture and overheating and use it in dry rooms only.
- Do not drop the product and do not expose it to any major shocks.
- Do not operate the product outside the power limits given in the specifications.
- Do not modify the device in any way. Doing so voids the warranty.
- Do not continue to operate the device if it becomes visibly damaged.
- Use the product for its intended purpose only.
- Keep this product, as all electrical products, out of the reach of children!
- Do not use the product in the immediate vicinity of heaters or other heat sources or in direct sunlight.
- Lay all cables so that they do not pose a tripping hazard.
- Do not bend or crush the cable.
- Always pull directly on the plug when disconnecting the cable, never on the cable itself.
- · Dispose of packaging material immediately according to locally applicable
- · regulations.
- The product is intended for indoor use only.
- Use the item only in moderate climatic conditions.
- Do not use the product in areas where the use of electronic devices is not permitted.
- Do not use the product in moist environments and avoid splashes. Children are not allowed to play or use the
 equipment.
- Do not let children play with plastic bags, foils or small parts.
- There is a danger of swallowing or suffocating!
- The device is intended only for private use.
- Always disconnect the item from the mains when not in use

- The socket is suitable for use in ambient temperatures that do not usually exceed 25°C, but occasionally reach 35°C.


Before connecting a terminal device, check whether the power output of the charger can supply sufficient power for the device.

- Ensure that the power of the connected terminal device does not exceed the max. rated power.

Product overview / Specifications




Mounting


1. Remove the protective sheet from adhesive sticker



2. Stick the Dock on a flat surface, you can also mount under the table



3. Twist and lock



4. Activate all ports (incl. 230V Sockets)



Cleaning and maintenance

Danger! Always pull out the mains power plug before starting any cleaning work. Keep all safety devices, air vents and the housing free of dirt and dust as far as possible. Wipe the equipment with a clean cloth.

- Clean the equipment regularly with a moist cloth and some soft soap. Do not use cleaning agents or solvents; these could attack the plastic parts of the equipment. Ensure that no water can seep into the device. The ingress of water into an electric tool increases the risk of an electric shock.
- The charger should be placed in a dry room for storage

Disposal
