




OVERVIEW



- 1. SCROLL WHEEL
- 2. DPI SWITCH BUTTON (800/1200/1600)
- 3. SENSOR
- 4. BATTERY COMPARTMENT
- 5. USB RECEIVER

Remove the battery door, install 2 X 1.5V"AAA" size batteries into the battery compartment. Ensure the batteries are installed correctly with regard to polarity(+/-) as shown inside the battery compartment and colse the battery door. Plug USB receiver into USB port of laptop/PC. To change DPI press DPI switch button. Make sure that USB receiver is installed into USB port properly and distance to mouse is less than 10m.



FCC
