

Introduction

SAMBA Service can allow you to browse and update the IFP's files and storage from another device.

Setup steps


1. Enable the Samba service

- Go to Android settings – Samba service, tick the Samba
- Tick the “use password for protection” if you need use a password to login



2. Check the IP address of this IFP

- Go to Android settings – WiFi – tap the icon of your WiFi that connected.




- Find the IP address of this IFP


3. Access through your Laptop or mobile devices
