



SETUP GUIDE

- **Unpack the Snake**: Take the infrared receiver, USB charging cord, batteries, and TR-A22 snake carefully out of the packing.
- Charge the Snake: Using the provided USB cable, connect the snake to a power source and give it a full charge before using it for the first time.
- Place Batteries in the Receiver: Carefully open the infrared receiver's battery box and place three LR44 batteries inside, making that they are polarized correctly.
- Activate the Snake: To activate the snake, hit the power button, which is often found on its underside.
- **Switch on the Receiver**: To initiate communication with the snake, switch on the infrared receiver by pushing the assigned button.
- **Test Basic motions:** Test the snake's left, right, and forward basic motions using the infrared receiver.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- Steer clear of Direct Sunlight: Extended exposure to direct sunlight may cause the snake's plastic components to deteriorate or fade in color.
- Stay Away from Small Parts: To prevent choking hazards, make sure that all small parts, including the batteries, are stored together and out of small children's reach.
- Recharge the snake as soon as possible after each usage to make sure it's prepared for the following gaming session.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Snake not moving	Batteries are dead	Replace the batteries with fresh ones.
Remote control unresponsive	Weak batteries in remote	Replace the remote control batteries.
Snake stops mid-motion	Signal interference	Move to an area with less signal interference.
Snake not rattling	Batteries may be low	Replace the batteries with new ones.
Limited range on remote c ontrol	Weak batteries	Ensure the remote has fresh batteries.
Snake moves slowly	Batteries are running low	Replace with fully charged batteries.
Buttons on remote not wor king	Dust or debris inside buttons	Clean the remote control carefully.
Snake not responding to c ommands	Signal obstruction	Ensure there are no obstructions between the remo te and the snake.
Snake only moves in one direction	Malfunctioning remote	Try resetting the remote or replacing batteries.
Remote control signal is w eak	Interference from other devic es	Avoid using near other remote-controlled devices.
Snake movement is jerky	Low battery power	Replace the batteries with fresh ones.
Snake not turning as expe	Misalignment of wheels or m echanisms	Check and adjust the wheels or mechanisms.
Rattling sound is faint	Low battery power	Replace with new batteries.
Remote control LED not li ghting up	Dead batteries	Replace the remote batteries.
