
BLUETOOTH INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. To start the pairing process turn on the Bluetooth™ device.
- 2. Press ON/OFF to turn on the speaker, and you will hear prompt tone.
- 3. Go to your Bluetooth setting on your device and click on "Duck Shower SPKR". When the speaker is paired successfully, you will hear "Di-Di"

Please note:

- *Make sure your device and speaker are within 30 feet.
- "Once the speaker is paired succe sfully, it will reconnect to you device automatically.
- "The speaker will automatically turn off if there is no connection after 5 minutes.

If the Wireless speaker cannot be paired with your device pleasetry the following:

If the Wireless speaker cannot be recharged:
