## Features

## Installation


1. The minimum distance between the transmitter and ground is 1.5m.

2. The minimum distance between the receiver and the transmitter is 1 m.
3. Do not install on a metal object, or the transmit distance will be affected.
4. Do not install it in a damp and sun exposed place, otherwise the service life will be affected .


## Cautions

Please observe the following regulations while complying with the effective electricity standards:

- Transmit range: within 80 meters in open space
- Avoid static interference, which may damage the electronic components.



## Operations



### 1. Control

Make curtain up

Make curtain stop

Make curtain down

### 2. Channel selection

Right select key: Channel increment

Left Select key: Channel decrement

### 3. Channel-lock (Available for 6 and 16 channels)

Channel-Lock: Press “stop” + “right or left select key” 3s till the LED lights to lock current channel, after the operation done, other channel cannot be used except for the locked channel.

## Cautions


